Overview for the next 7 days

Tonight Through Sunday Morning

Moderate tidal flooding possible near Annapolis, Straits Point late Sat/Sun nights.

Monday Through Thursday


No widespread hazardous weather is expected at this time.





Moderate Coastal Flooding Possible

Late Saturday night-early Sunday morning, late Sunday night-early Monday morning



- Minor coastal flooding likely during high tide through Saturday afternoon.
- Coastal Flood Watch in effect over the weekend for Anne Arundel & St. Mary's Counties for possible moderate coastal flooding:
 - Saturday night into Sunday morning.
 - Sunday night into Monday morning.



Severe Weather Possible

Wednesday and Thursday (next week)






- Scattered severe thunderstorms capable of producing damaging 60 mph wind gusts and hail are possible.
 - Confidence: Low
 - Potential Impact: Low






Isolated Flooding Possible

Wednesday and Thursday (next week)






- Heavy rainfall may cause isolated instances of flooding.
 - Confidence: Low
 - Potential Impact: Low

Near normal to slightly above normal temperatures




