No widespread hazardous weather is expected at this time.






Soaking Rain Expected

Through Wednesday Night






- Soaking Rain expected, especially late Tuesday night through Wednesday.

 - A few stronger storms are possible with gusty winds and heavy rain that may lead to isolated instances of flooding.


Map Valid 8 AM Friday






8-14 Day Outlooks; May 20-26, 2024

Near normal to slightly above normal temperatures




