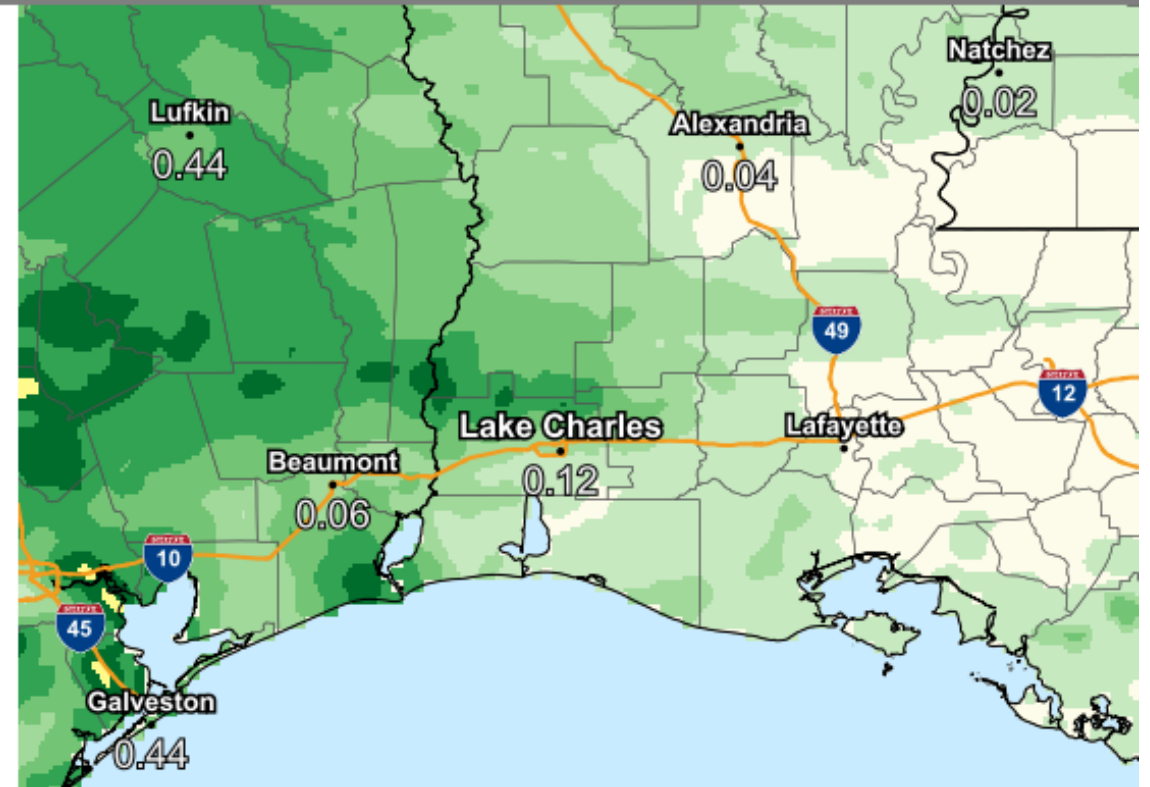
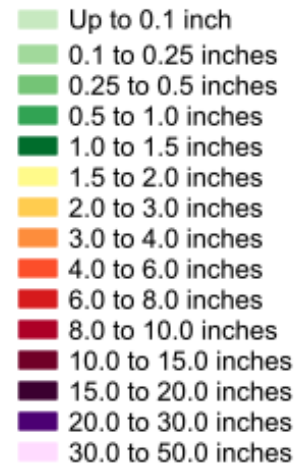
**Mild and dry weather continues through the weekend. A cold front is expected early next week bringing better rain chances and slightly cooler temps.**

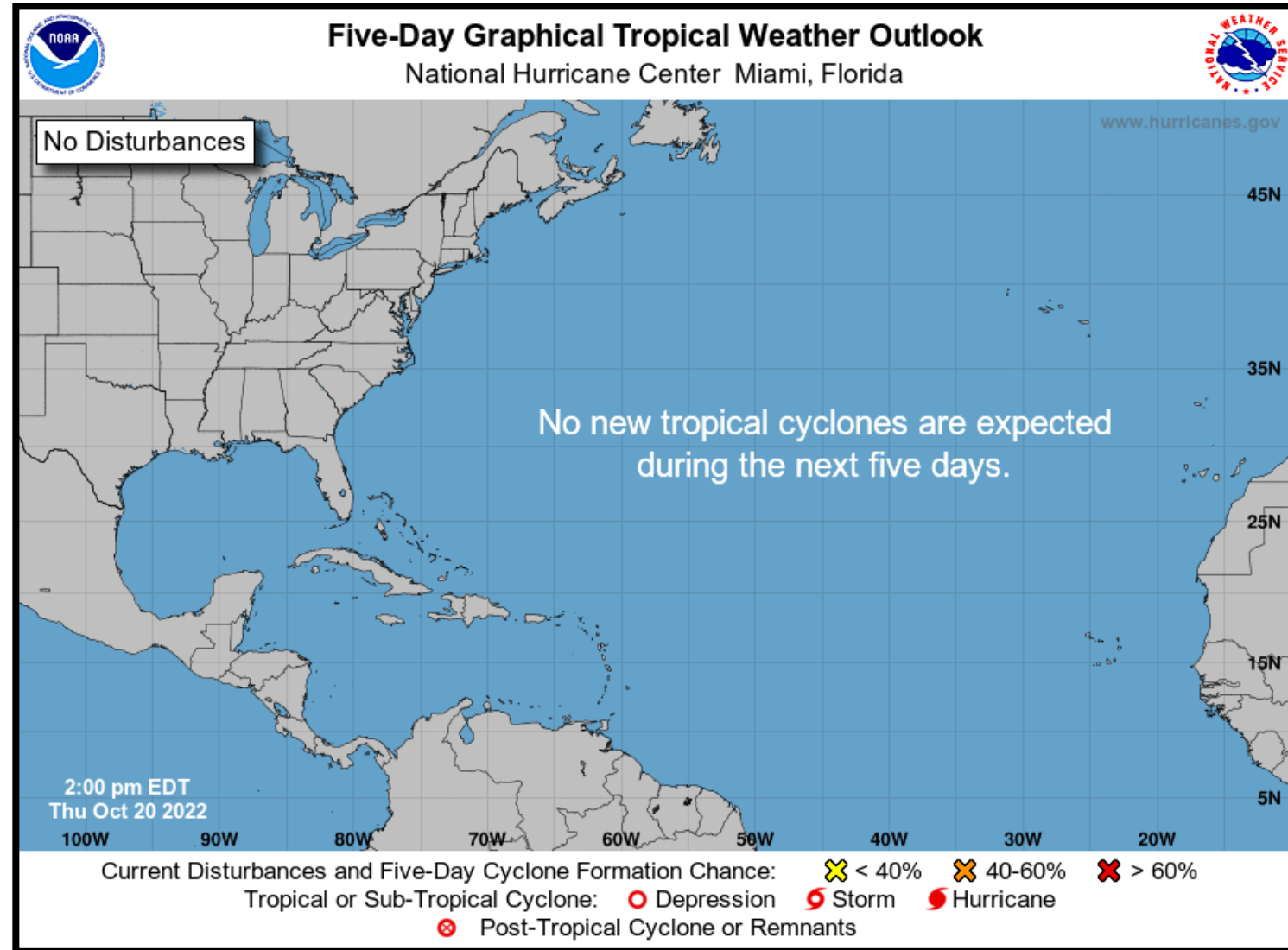

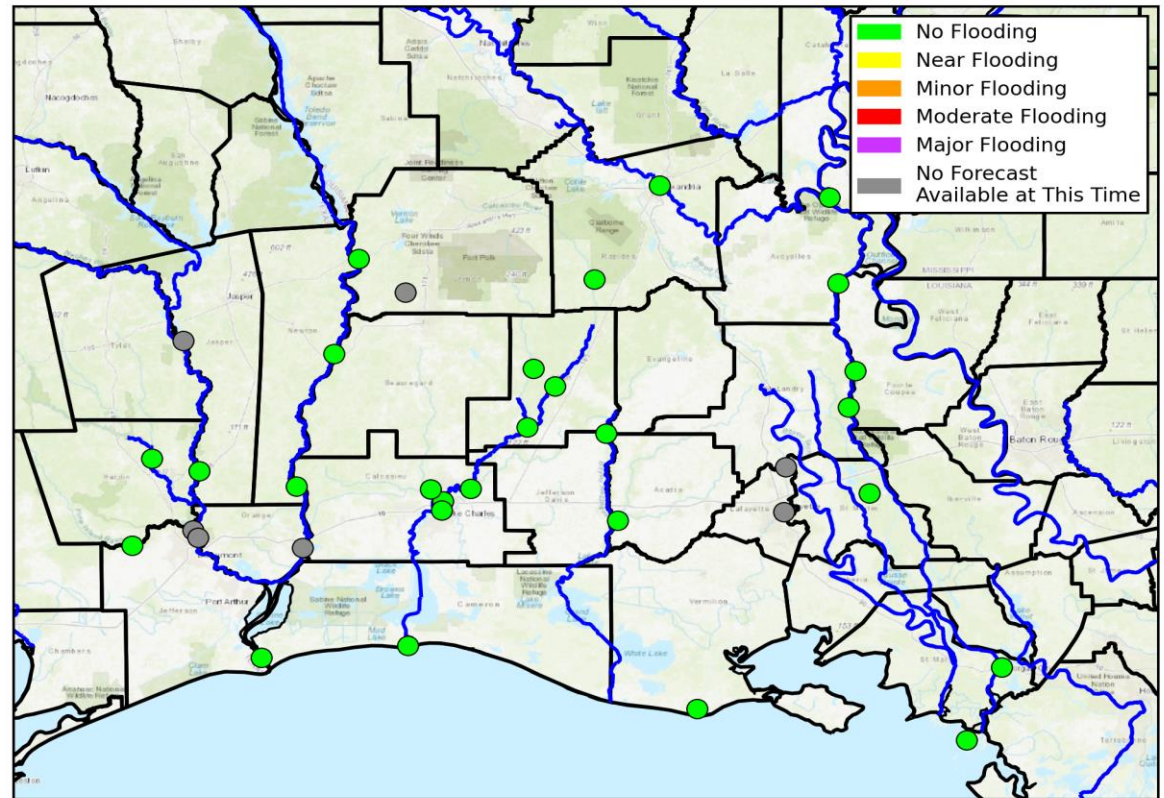
Around a 0.1-.3 inches of rain fell earlier this week ahead of a cold front. Otherwise dry weather has been ongoing.

No river flooding is ongoing or expected to begin this week.



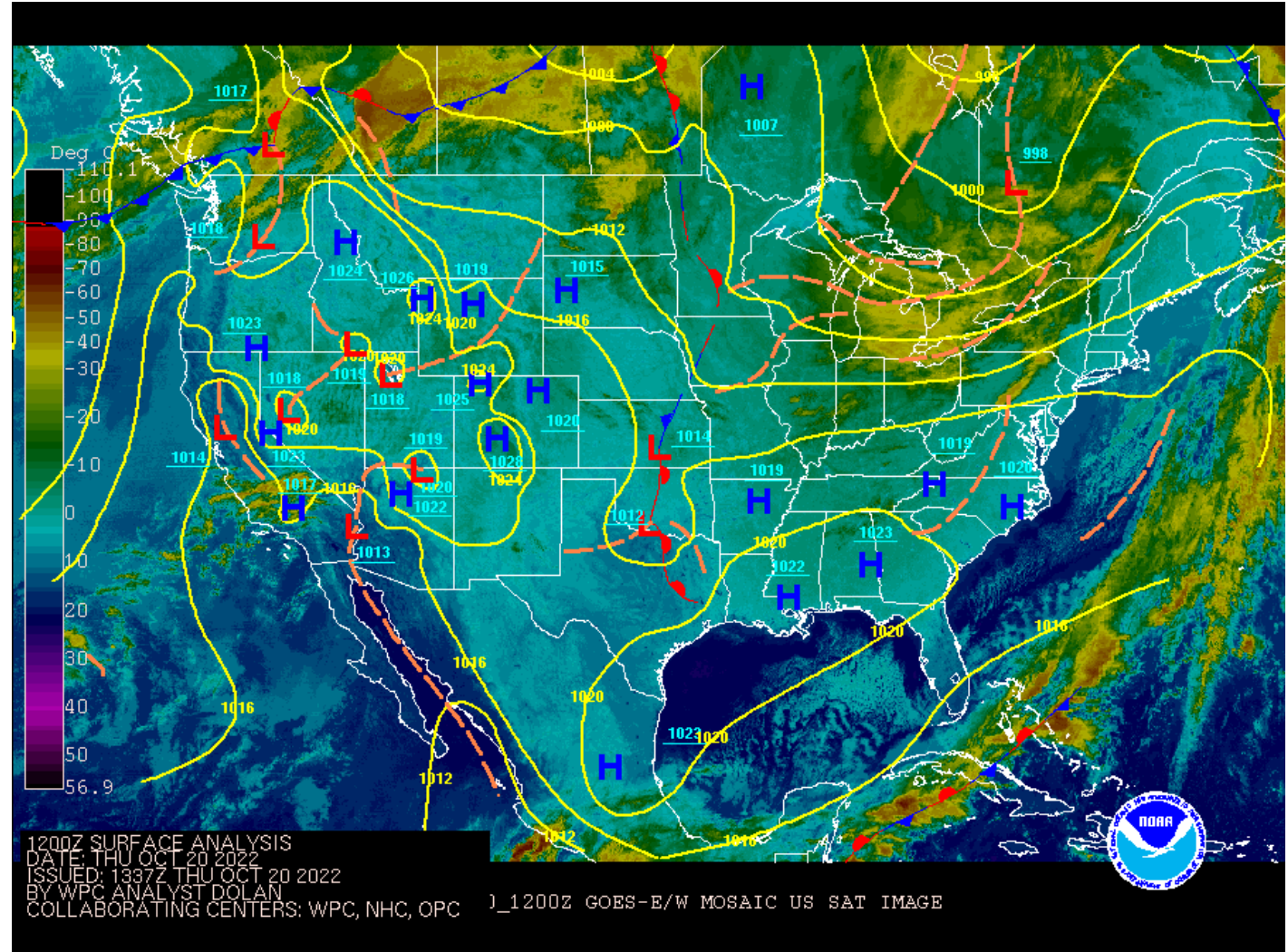


# Surface Weather Map with Fronts

High pressure extends across the southeastern US to Mexico, providing light winds and clear skies across the local area today.





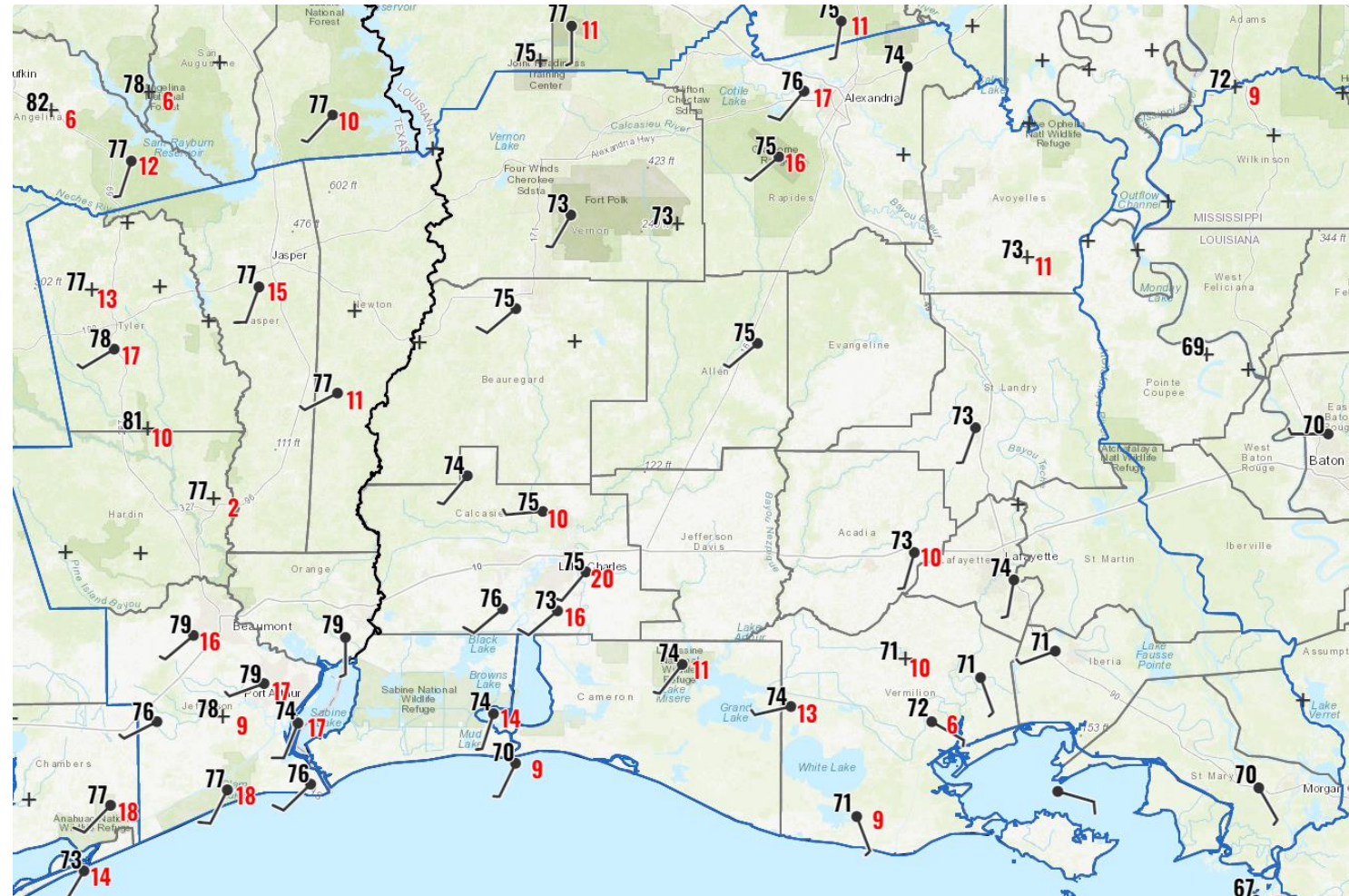


# 2 pm Weather Observations

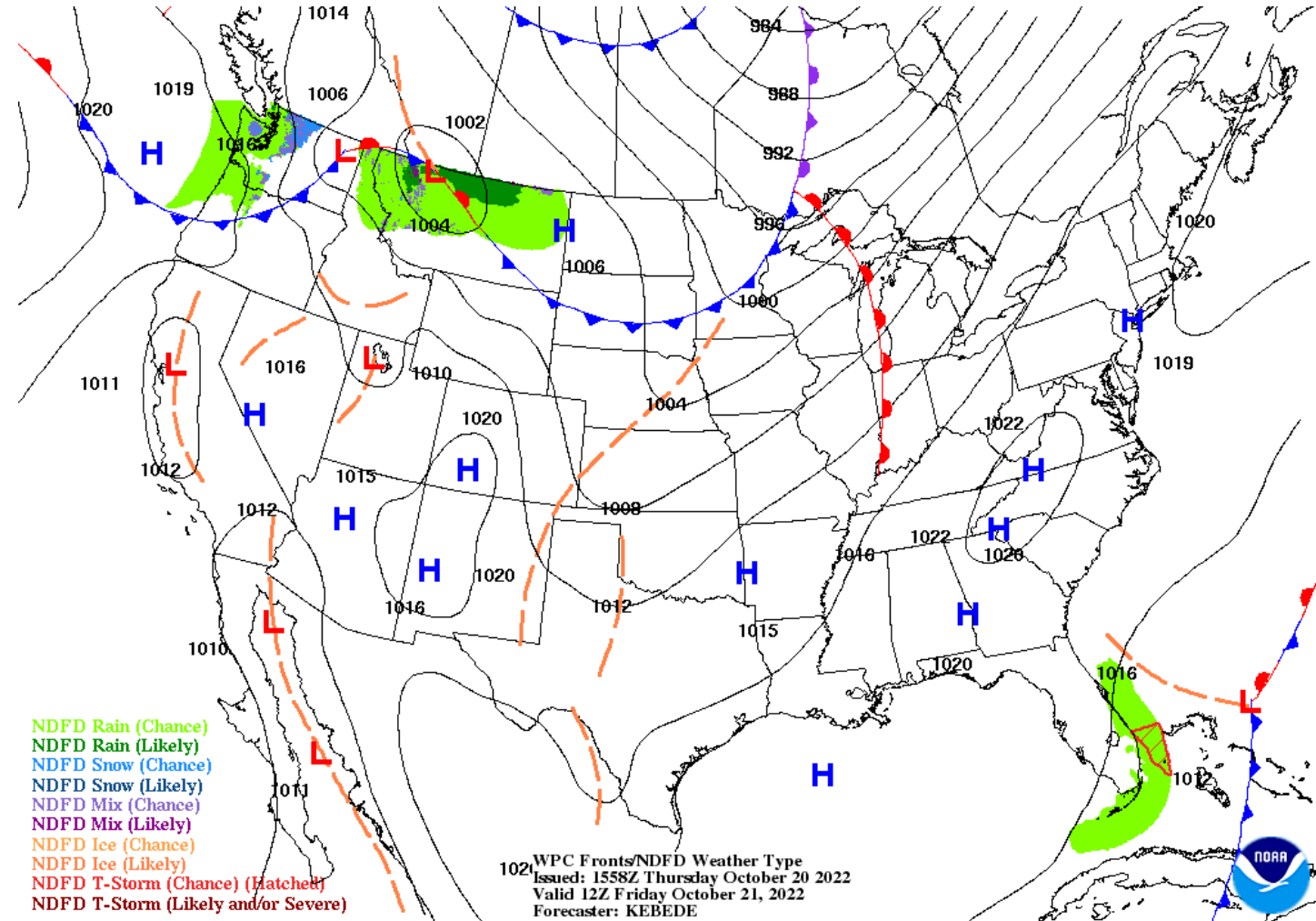


Warm and sunny conditions to persist for the rest of the day with cool temperatures expected tonight.
