TOP STORY:


A very wet Thanksgiving weekend looks on tap for the region. After dry days to start the new week, another storm system brings rain chances back to the forecast.

Rainfall in the Past Week




Rain amounts were rather scant across the northern half of the area, with higher amounts nearer the coast.



Tropical Weather Outlook




The tropics remain quiet, as expected.



River Forecasts




We currently have no rivers in flood.



Upper Level Steering Patterns




General westerly flow aloft at the moment is expected to give way to an advancing Pacific storm system over the coming days.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts




High pressure ridging from the Appalachians remains in control at the surface.



6 am Weather Observations




Skies were generally clear, while temperatures were on the cool side.



I pm Weather Observations




Warm and mostly sunny with temperatures generally in the 70s.



Rest of the Day








Clouds will begin increasing later this afternoon into tonight. Look for shower activity to begin later tonight.



Excessive Rainfall Outlook - Thursday




There is a slight chance for excessive rainfall on Thursday into Friday.



Severe Weather Outlook - Thursday




There is a marginal risk for severe weather for portions of the forecast area for Thursday into Friday.

Excessive Rainfall Outlook – Friday




The slight risk for excessive rainfall will continue into Saturday.





Weekly Weather Summary



 A Pacific storm system will bring widespread showers and some thunderstorms into the holiday weekend.

 There is a SLIGHT RISK for excessive rainfall across the entire area...and a marginal risk for severe weather over portions of SE Texas and the SW corner of Louisiana.

 Dry weather Sunday and Monday will be replaced by another round of showers beginning Tuesday.
