Numerous tree limbs were blown down along with some small trees uprooted. Wind gusts were measured to 60 mph in Pontiac and to 59 mph in Peru, Libertyville and near Chicago Midway Airport. Shingles were blown off houses in Channahon. Utility poles were blown down in Batavia and shingles were blown off a roof in North Aurora. In addition to the strong winds, numerous snow squalls moved across the area, some of the strongest produced near zero visibility and thundersnow.
