

Regional Climate Summary

January 2019

This January was especially mild as temperatures departures were at or above normal, while precipitation was well below normal throughout most of the region. The month began with a few cold days following a strong arctic front. Portions of the Permian Basin saw light ice and sleet on the 2nd and a dusting of snow on the 3rd. A quick warm up followed this cold snap as temperatures rebounded well above normal. The only noteworthy storm system brought brief showers and thunderstorms to the area on the 11th. Otherwise, mainly dry conditions and above normal temperatures extended through the remainder of the month.
