




Weak Front Moving Through 4/19/15


The active weather during the week had several different causes. The severe weather on the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> was caused by a trough of low pressure over New Mexico creating lift along the Rio Grande Plains.


A large upper level low pressure system situated over the 4-corners region of the Western U.S. and the upper level Subtropical Jet lead to the Severe Weather on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. The low pressure was slow to move off to the east. The West Texas dryline also contributed to the storms across our westerns counties each afternoon and evening.

By the 19<sup>th</sup>, the low pressure had pushed to the east but a surface boundary/weak front was draped across South Central Texas. A few thunderstorms formed across Bastrop, Fayette, and Lavaca Counties as this boundary pushed south. This boundary separated moist air ahead of it and drier air behind it. It helped lift the air to produce the isolated thunderstorms across areas east of Interstate 35.

Greatest threat is where up to 5 inches of rain fell yesterday and an additional 2 to 4 inches of additional rain is possible.




- A Flash Flood Watch means that heavy rainfall may lead to Flash Flooding.




