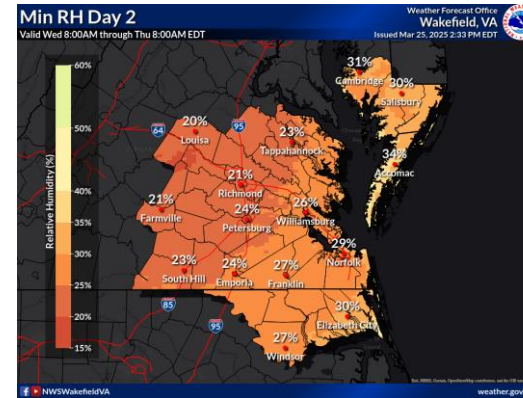

There are no major weather concerns through Friday.

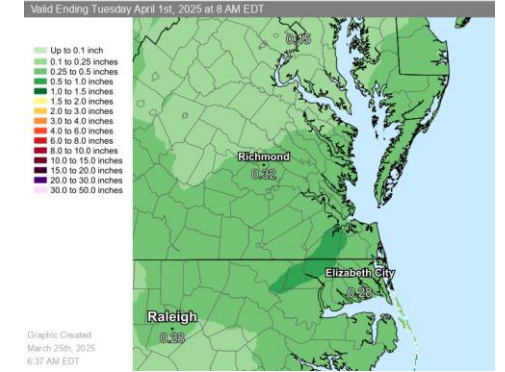
Showers are likely tonight, particularly across central and eastern Virginia.

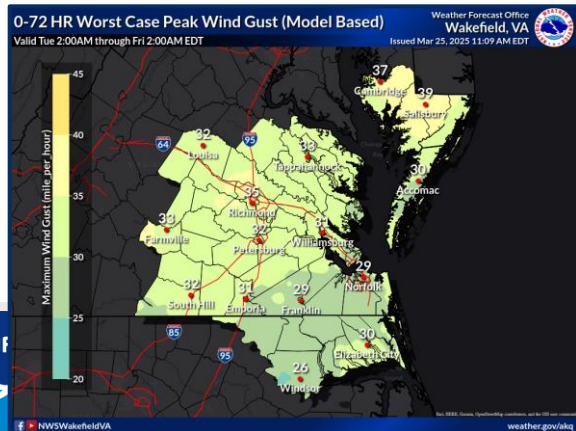
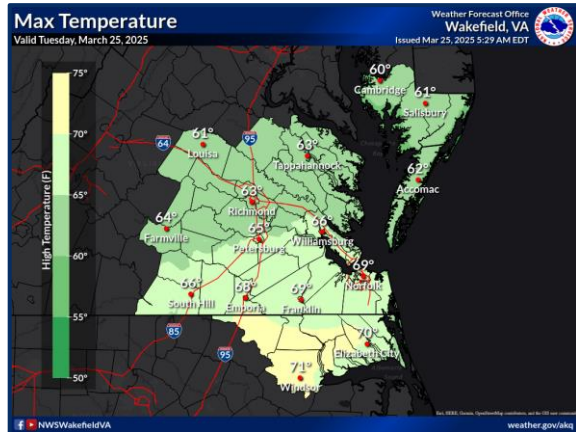


Seven Day Precipitation Fcst

Central VA (incl Tri-Cities): Increasing clouds. Highs mid 60s. Lows 40-45.

Piedmont: Increasing clouds with a chance of showers late. Highs mid 60s. Lows lower 40s.

South Central VA / Inland NC: Mostly sunny with increasing clouds in the afternoon. Highs: 65 to 70. Lows: 40 to 45.

Eastern Shore (MD/VA): Mostly sunny, becoming partly sunny. Highs: Upper 50s. Lows: lower 40s.

Northern Neck/Mid Penn: Mostly sunny, becoming partly sunny.. Highs: lower 60s. Lows: lower 40s.

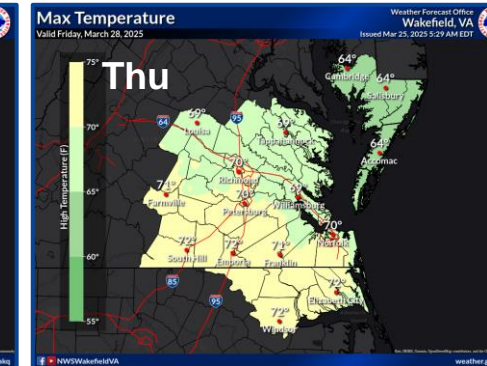
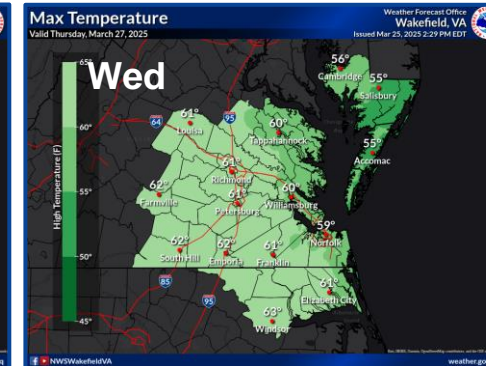
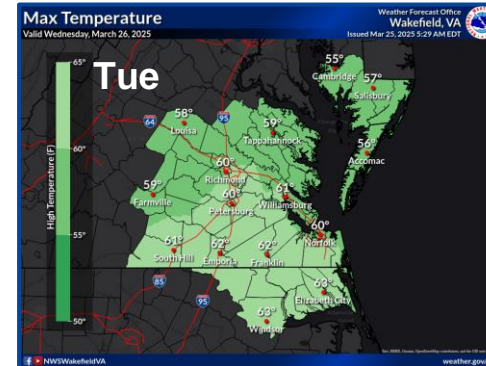
Tidewater/Peninsula: Mostly sunny early, becoming partly sunny in the afternoon. Highs: upper 60s. Lows: mid 40s.

Hampton Roads: Mostly sunny, becoming partly sunny in the afternoon. Highs: upper 60s. Lows: upper 40s.

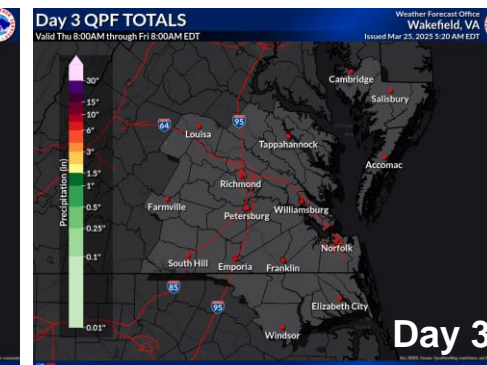
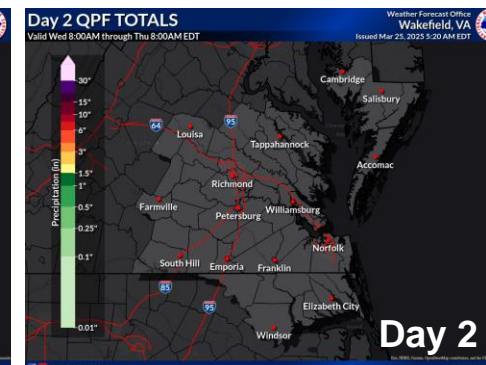
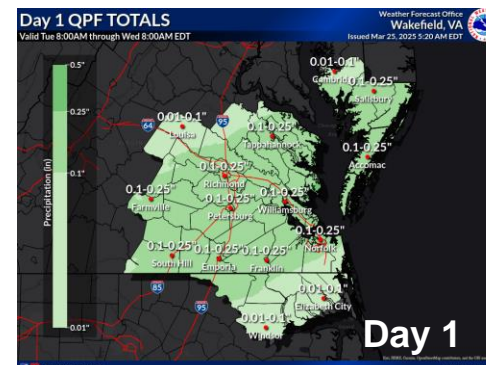
NE North Carolina: Mostly sunny early, becoming partly sunny in the afternoon. Highs: upper 60s. Lows: upper 40s.
