Definitions for DENSE FOG

DENSE FOG ADVISORY - issued when widespread dense fog develops. When this happens, visibilities frequently drop to one-quarter of a mile or less. These conditions make travel dangerous.



DENSE FOG

Small Decisions can have a **BIG IMPACT.**

- Slow down when visibility is reduced
- Don't use cruise control
- Delay travel until conditions improve

-  Be ready for sudden changes in visibility
-  Turn on your low-beam headlights when approaching fog
-  Drive slowly, and keep your distance from other vehicles
-  Use extra caution on bridges and in valleys
