Survey Summary:

An EF-0 tornado occurred along Route 28 just south of The Glen. Numerous trees were snapped and uprooted, and several utility poles were also snapped or downed. The tornado traveled to the northeast and produced additional tree damage along State Route 9 near Tripp Lake Road. The tornado crossed Interstate 87 near exit 24 and produced pockets of tree damage as it continued east. The tornado dissipated near Federal Hill Road.
