Announcement for the 2025 NWS Boston Summer Student Volunteer Program

The National Weather Service (NWS) in Boston/Norton, MA is accepting applications for our 2025 Summer Student Volunteer Program through Friday, February 28, 2025.

This program is open to undergraduate students majoring in meteorology (or any of the physical sciences) or to graduate students with a background in meteorology. You must be an enrolled student in the fall of 2025 in order to be eligible. The purpose of the program is to give students the opportunity to learn more about NWS careers by gaining on-the-job experience.

The summer program at NWS Boston involves working on a project of your choice with a Meteorologist Mentor and spending time shadowing operational forecasters. Job shadows are also arranged with the Northeast River Forecast Center (which is located in our facility) as well as with the NWS Center Weather Service Unit (CWSU) which is located at the Boston Air Route Traffic Control Center in Nashua, NH and provides direct weather support to the FAA.
