and establishment of moderate and major flood stages

for the stream gauge at Coventry, VT on the

Black River (CVYV1)

Effective at 1200 Coordinated Universal Time on Thursday, January 9, 2025, the National Weather Service will redefine action stage and minor flood stage levels above Gauge Zero for the stream gauge at Coventry, VT (CVYV1) on the Black River. In addition, new moderate and major flood stage levels will be established at the site. Those are listed below. Moderate and major flood stages for this gauge were previously undefined.

Action Stage (REDEFINED) 6.0 feet
Minor Flood Stage (REDEFINED) 7.0 feet
Moderate Flood Stage (NEW) 8.0 feet
Major Flood Stage (NEW) 9.0 feet

These flood stage adjustments and accompanying impact statements will help enhance local situational awareness during future high water events. These changes are part of a recent evaluation of the floodplain and high water impacts with Coventry town officials and emergency management.
