



Flurries into early afternoon in the northern Midlands. No impacts expected. Snow amounts will likely be less than measurable ( < 1/10") or a dusting.



Cloud Cover will erode from west to east as a cold breeze picks up keeping temps in the mid to upper 30s north and low to mid 40s south of Columbia.







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



### Day 4-7 Forecast




### Warming trend through the extended forecast with low rain chances.
