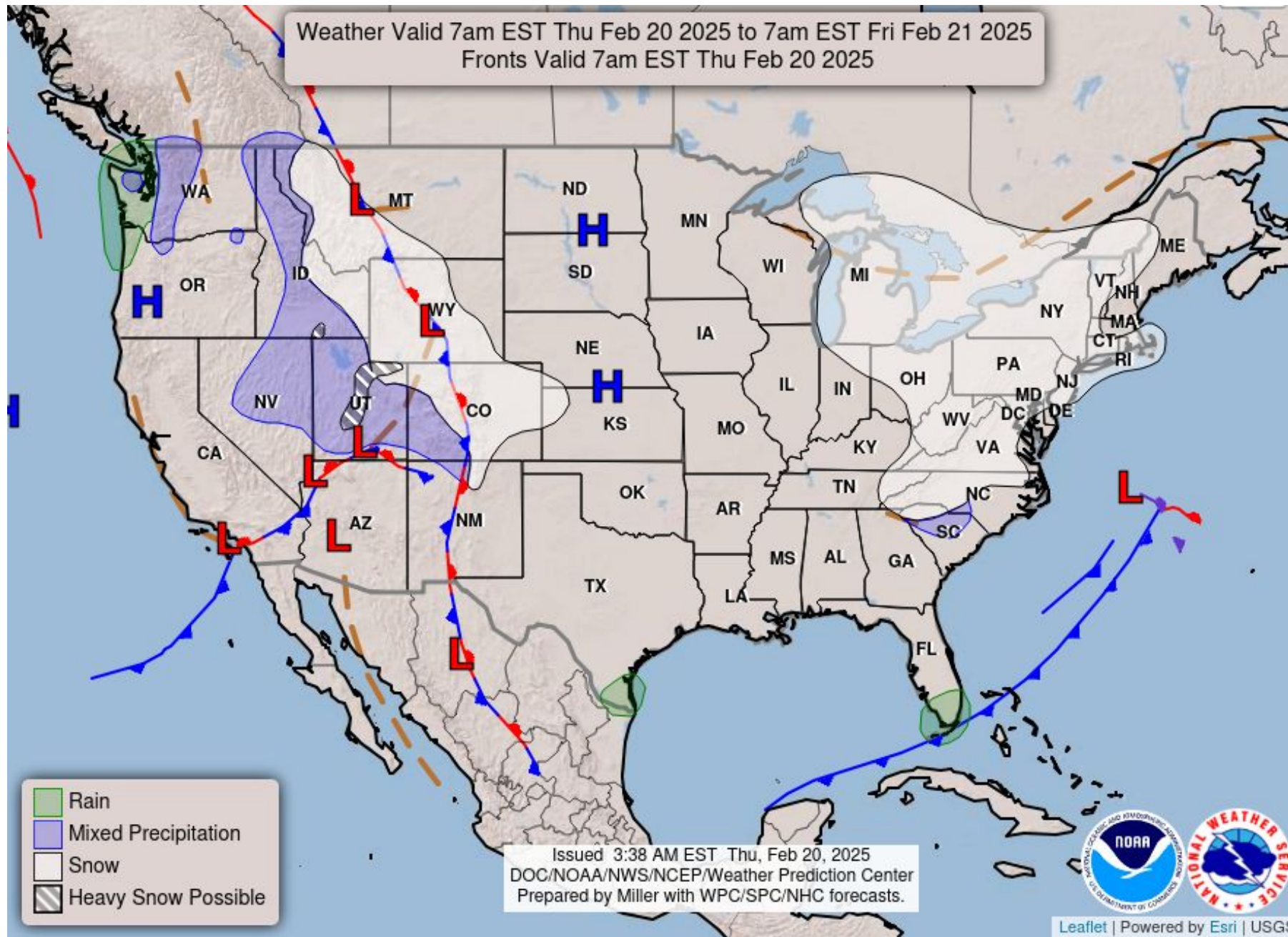

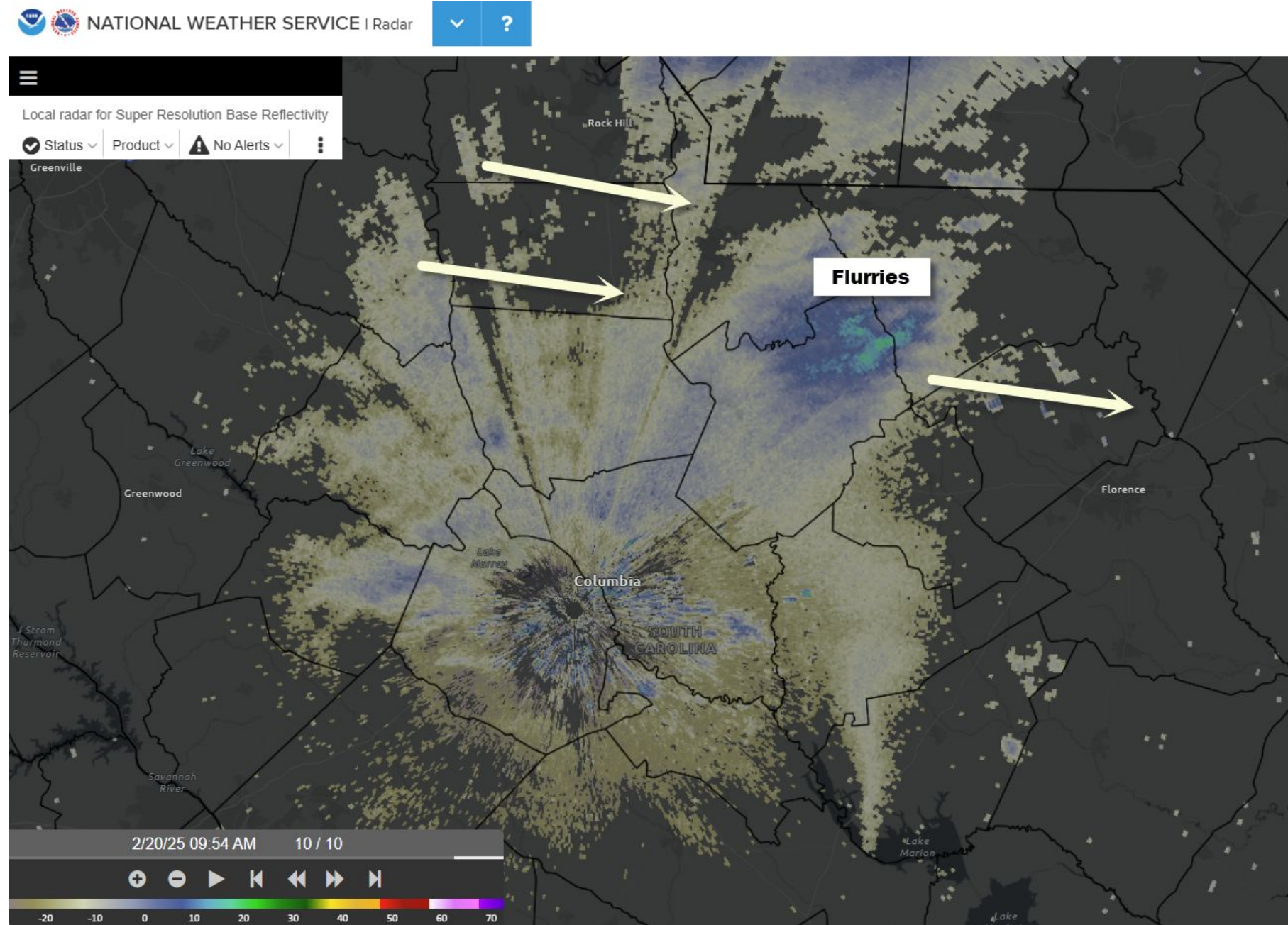

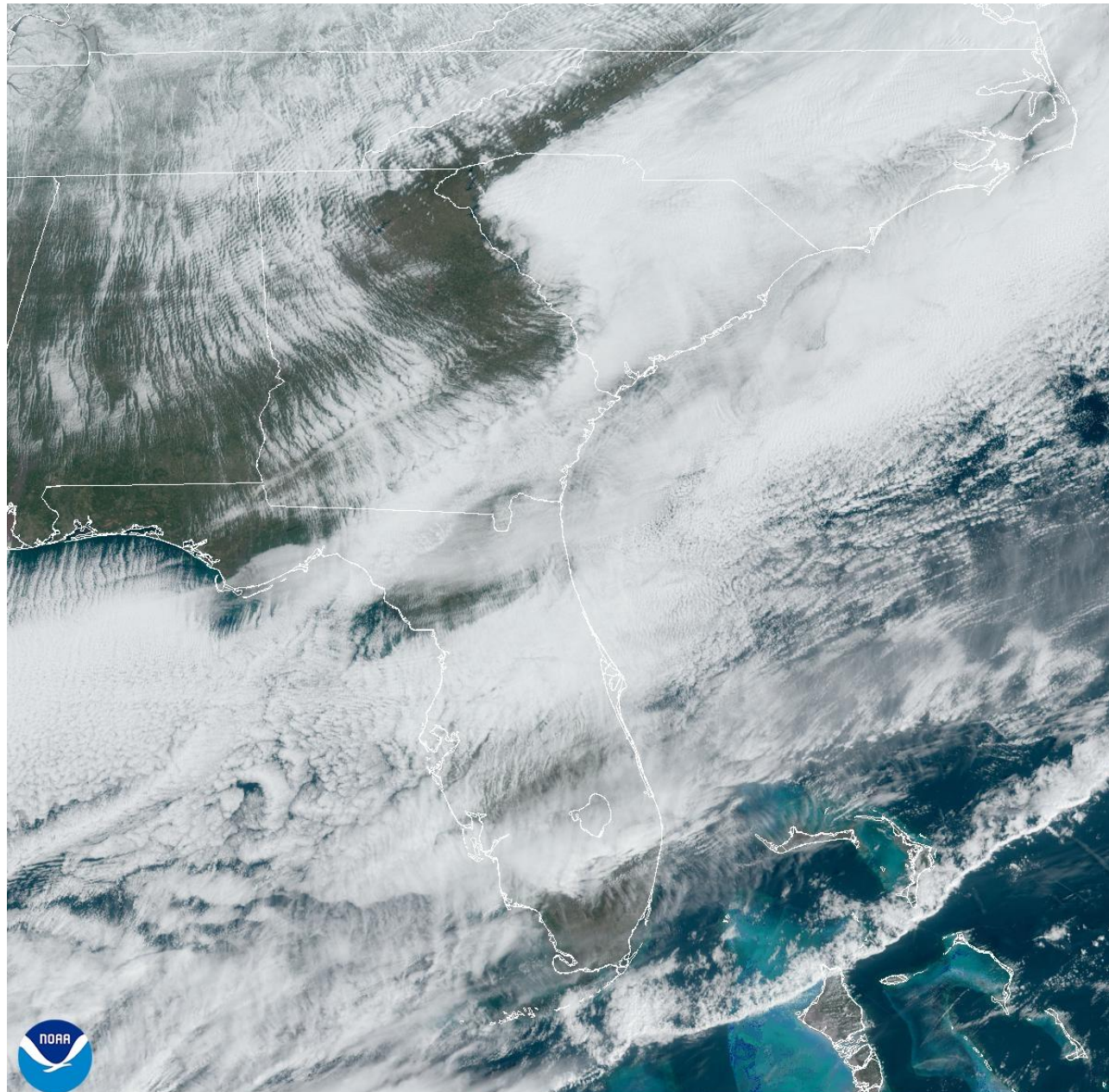


Flurries into early afternoon in the northern Midlands. No impacts expected. Snow amounts will likely be less than measurable (< 1/10") or a dusting.



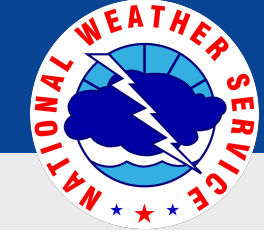
Satellite - Southeast

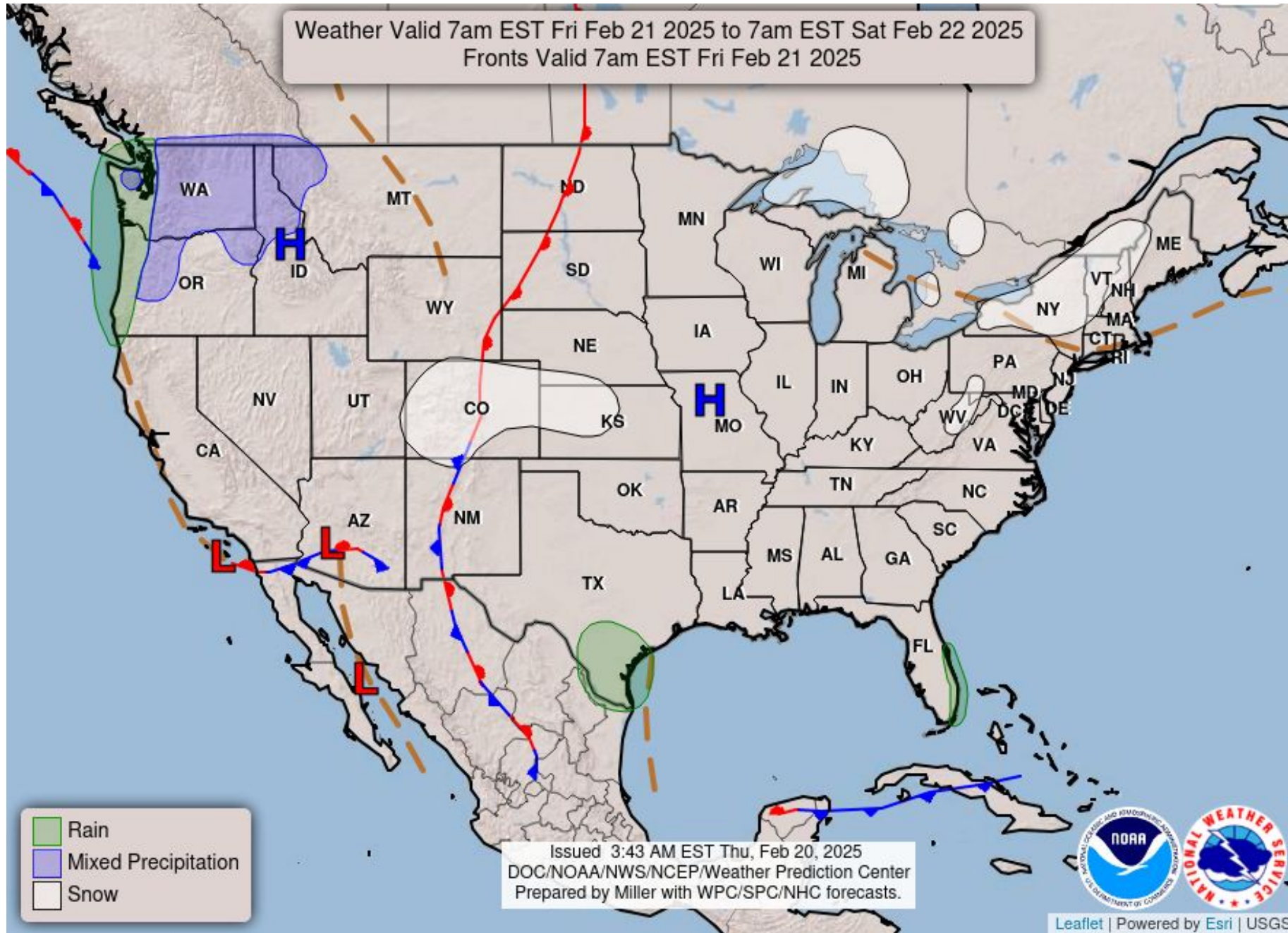

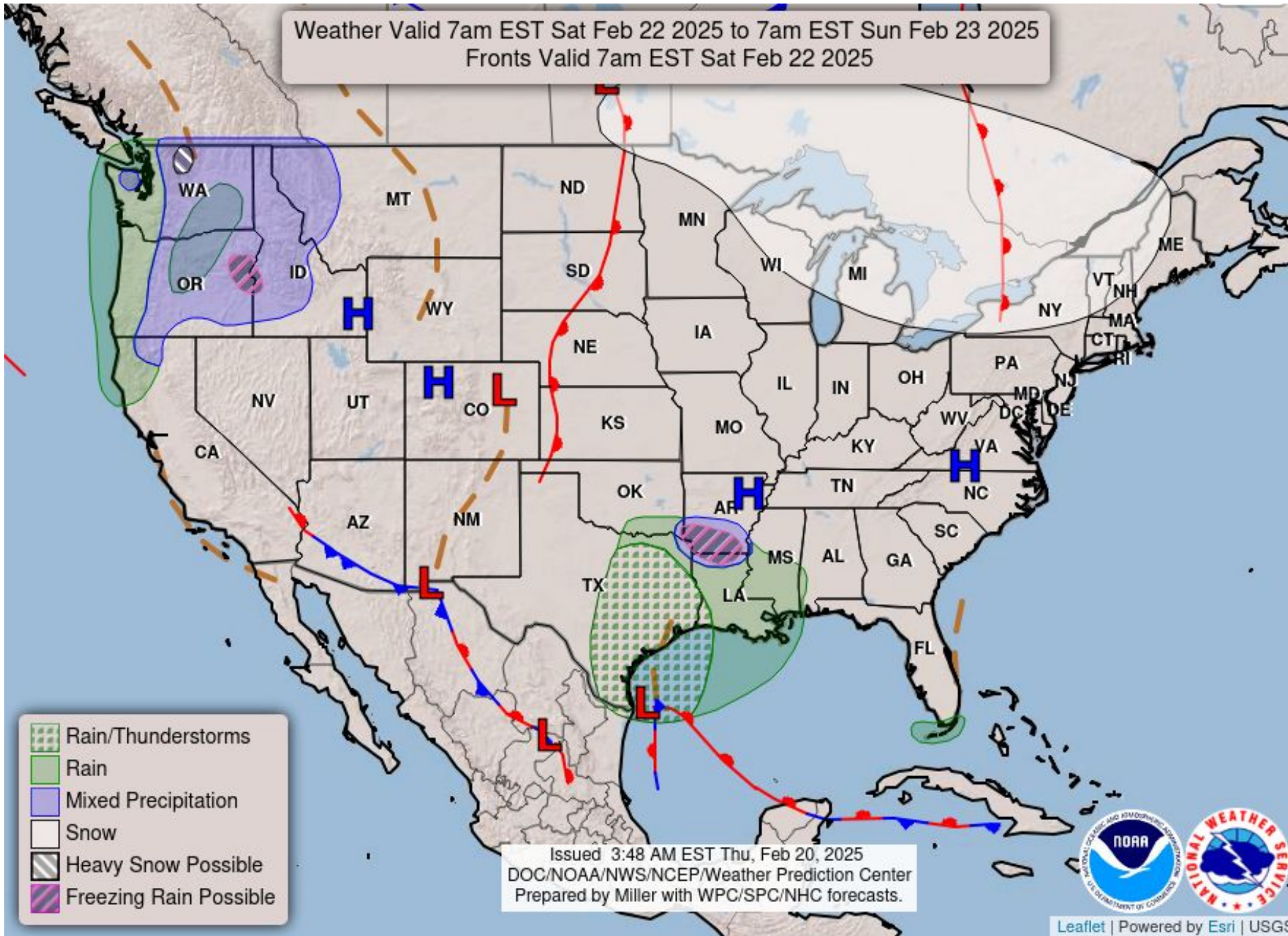


Cold, sunny day with highs in the mid to upper 40s.

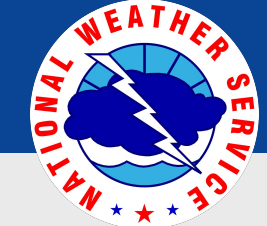


National Forecast - Saturday

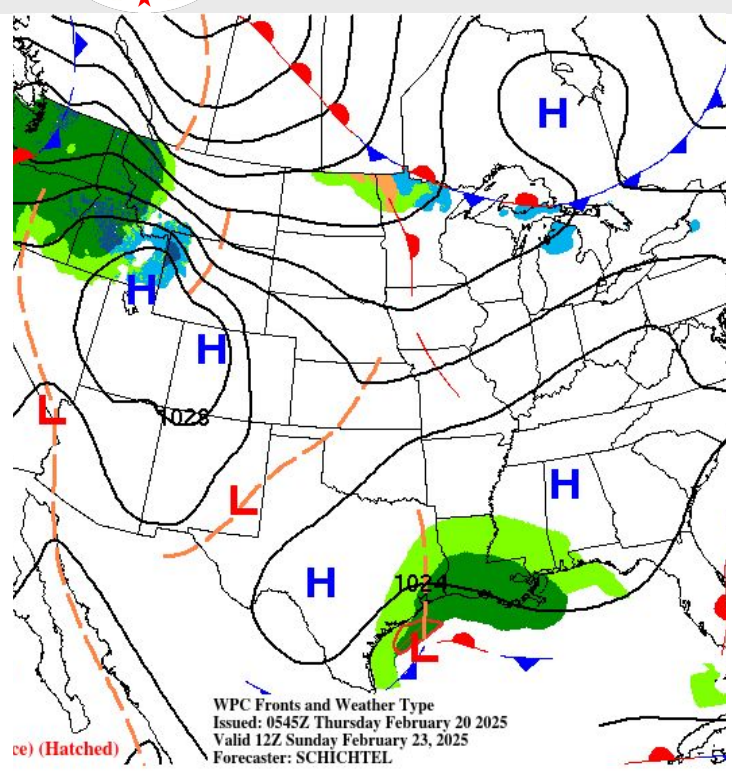


Temperatures warm slightly with highs in the mid 50s.

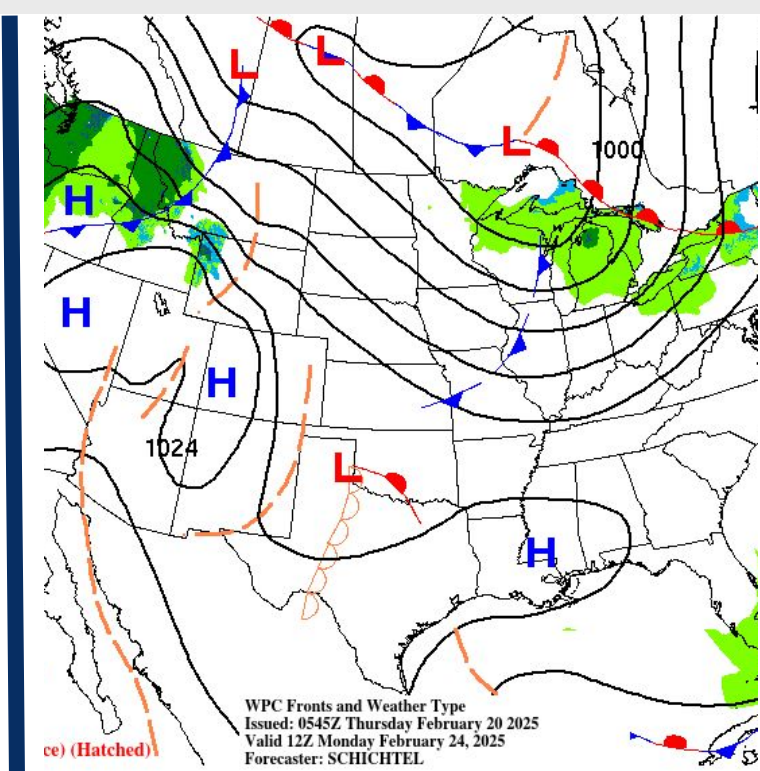

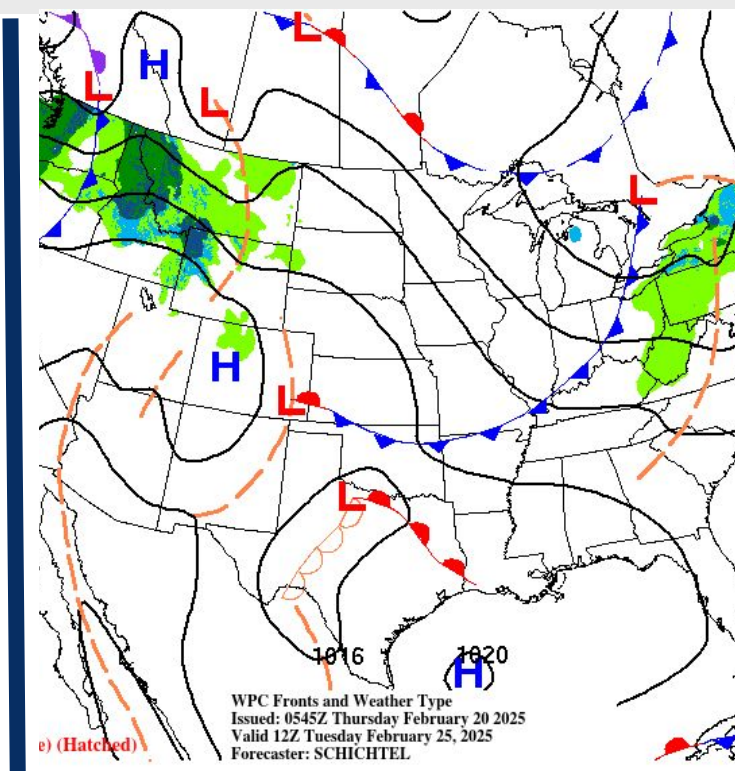

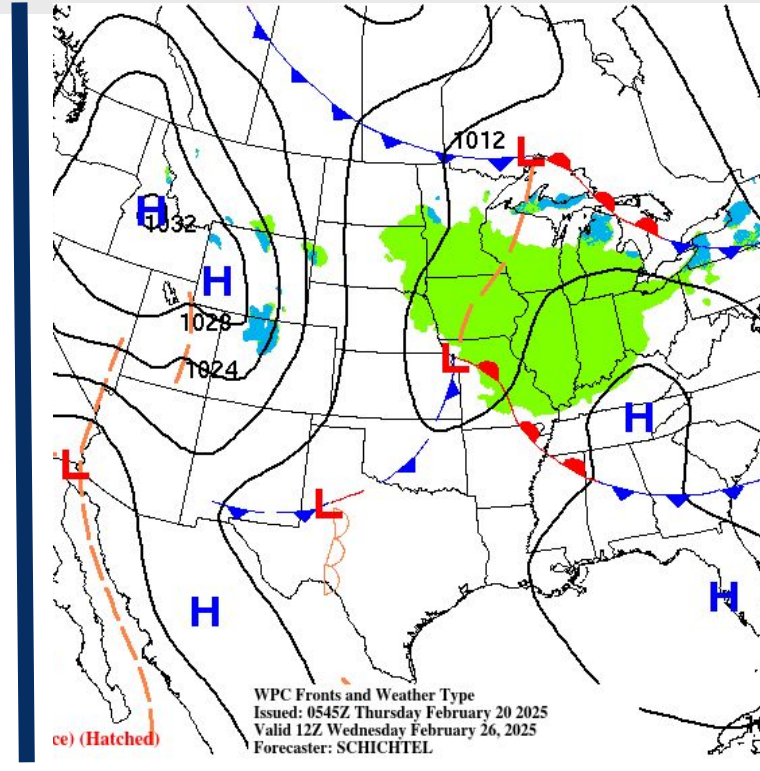

8-14 Day Outlook

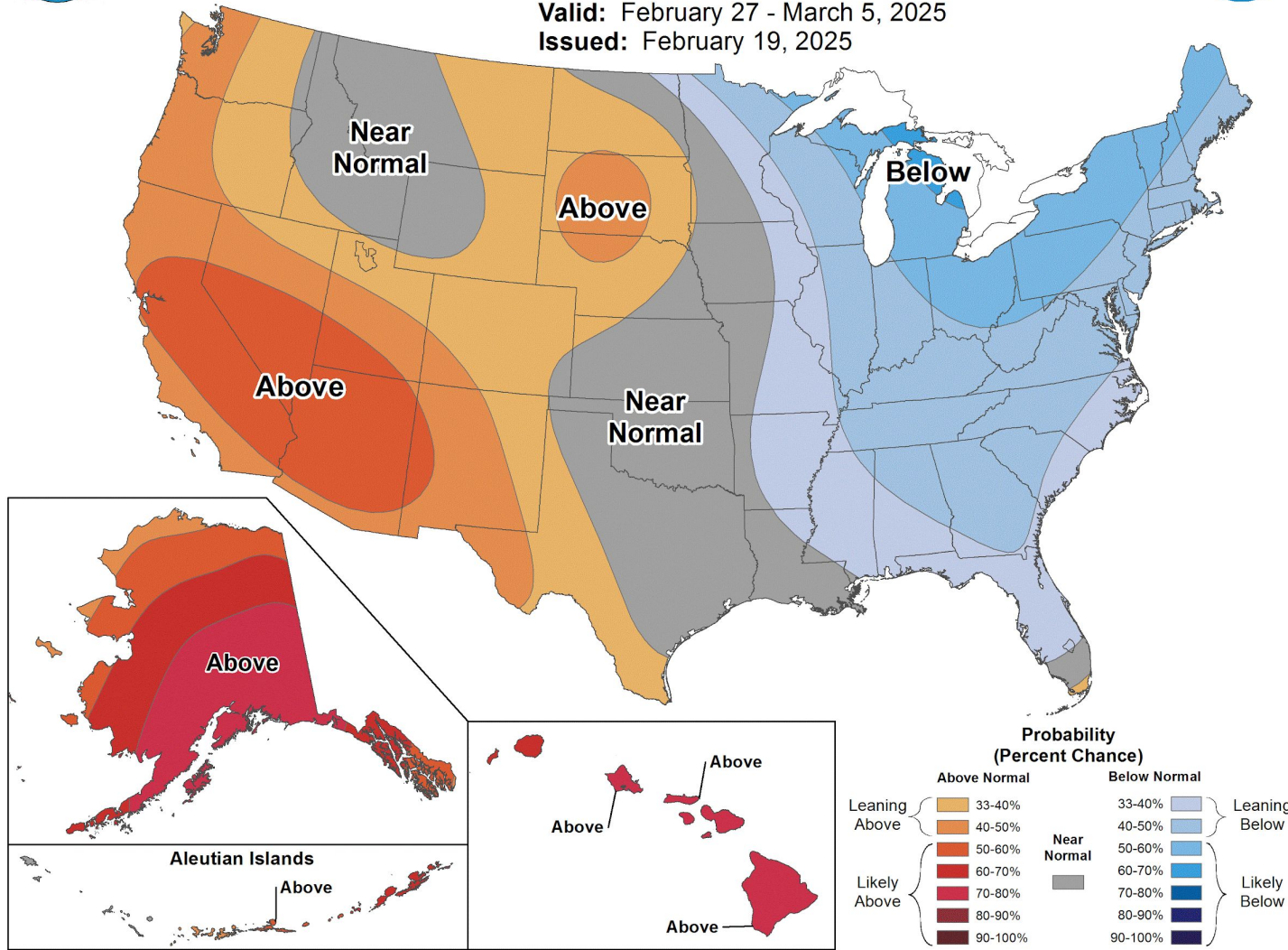

8-14 Day Temperature Outlook



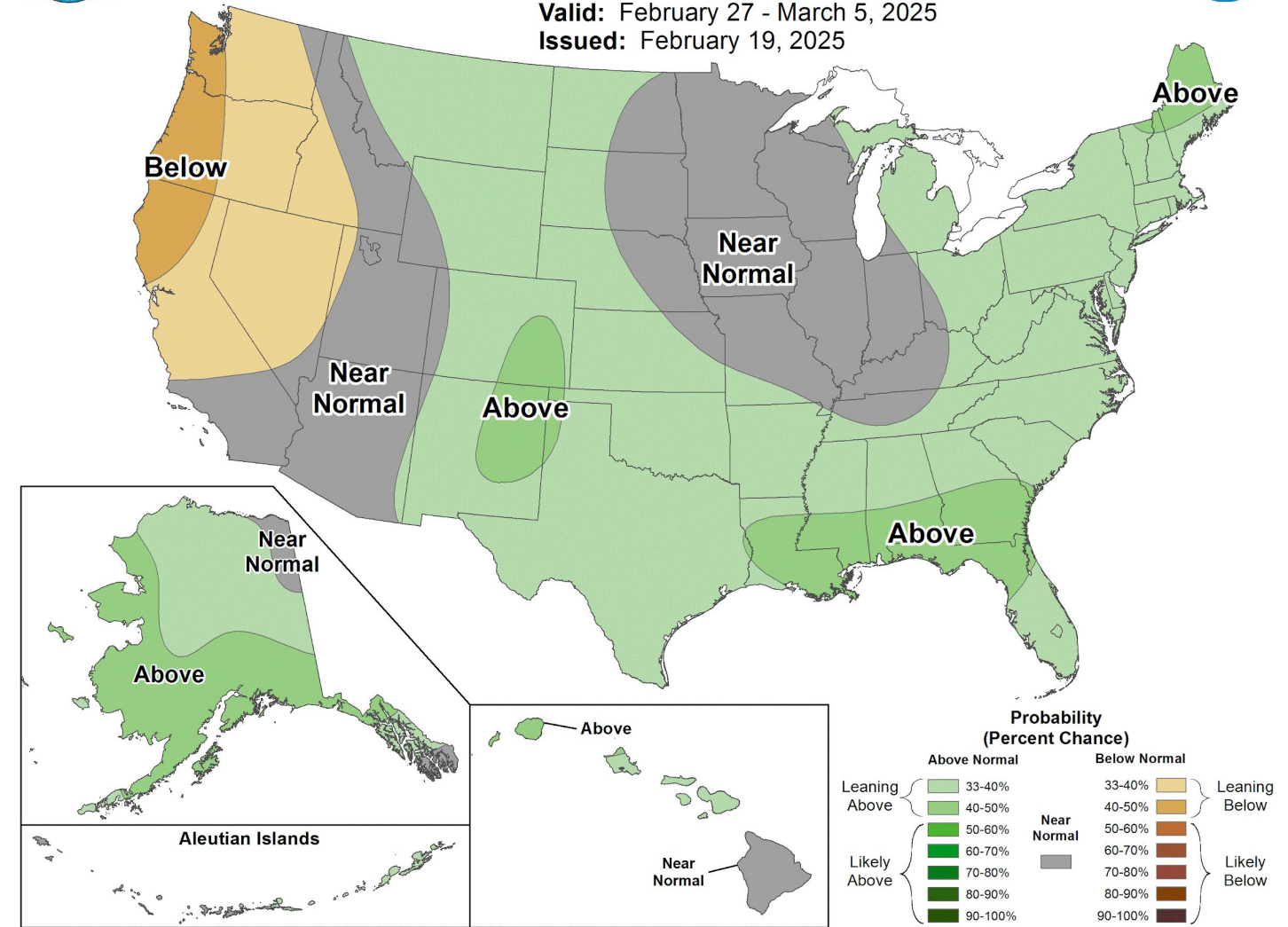
