- Foster interaction among NOAA and with partners by serving as effective liaisons.
- Elevate awareness and value of NOAA in the region.
- Build a more informed NOAA workforce.



NOAA in the Southeast and Caribbean

- Four states (NC, SC, GA, FL) and two territories (PR, USVI), 42 million people, and 18,000 miles of coastline
- 28 NOAA facilities and 2300 employees serving the NOAA mission

 State and university partners throughout the region, including Sea Grant Programs, Coastal Management Programs, Estuarine Research Reserves, and Cooperative Institutes





What is SECART?



Southeast and Caribbean Regional Collaboration Team (SECART)

- One of 8 teams in the Regional Collaboration Network (RCN)
- Collection of:
 - 18 NOAA representatives from most line offices
 - 4 core partners: SECOORA, NC NERRs, Sea Grant, CIMAS

- Progress through growing strategic partnerships (both internal and external) and a focus on cross-line office gaps in NOAA mission execution.
- Budget: \$50K annually

RCN History

- 2002: NOAA Administrator established five Regional Coordination pilot programs
- 2006: NOAA Executive Council assessed pilot programs and provided guidance to establish Regional Collaboration led by the Executive Oversight Group (DAAs from every line office) and overseen by the DUS-O
- 2009: Eight full-time coordinators hired to support Regional Collaboration teams nationwide
- 2016: DUS-O designated National Team Lead, Louisa Koch (Director, NOAA Office of Education) as senior executive sponsor; HQ liaison position created
