**Event Summary** 

Event Summary Hurricane Helene produced windespread sustained tropical storm force winds with gusts of 80-100 MPH in the CSRA and 70-90 MPH in the western Midlands. Widespread damage to trees and powerpoles, with ancilliary damage to hundreds of structures. Extended power outages for hundreds of thousands of residents. Major floading on most rivers, with record floading on Stephen's Creek in the Savannah River basin. Hurricane Helene also spawned 11 tornadoes in the CWA. 36 fatalities occurred as a result of the storm.

NOTE: It is unlikely that the point-based observations provided in this report sampled the peak values for the event.
