#### **Event Summary**

Debby made landfall near the Big Bend of Florida as a hurricane on the morning of August 5th before weakening to a tropical storm and moving very slowly along the Southeast coast through August 9th. Prolonged heavy rainfall across southeast Georgia and southeast South Carolina brought widespread flash flooding on August 5th and 6th, with considerable and prolonged flooding of creeks, streams, and main stem rivers exacerbated by additional rainfall for several days thereafter. Additionally, several nighttime tornadoes occured across the South Carolina Low Country on the night of August 5th. Scattered tree damage from near-tropical-storm-force winds resulted in some power and communications outages.

NOTE: It is unlikely that the point-based observations provided in this report sampled the peak values for the event.
