

County and City Impacts Associated with Hurricane Beryl (2024)

County Aransas	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: Voluntary
<p>Aransas county received just a glance from Beryl. Maximum wind gusts topped out at 40-50mph as Beryl passed to the east of the county. Rainfall totals were generally below 1 inch, but the islands of Aransas county may have been a bit higher. Voluntary evacuations were originally issued for the county. The number of residents that left is currently unknown.</p>			

County Bee	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
<p>Beryl remained well east of Bee county so we saw minimal impacts. Bee county received generally 0.5" or less of rain, though isolated higher amounts may have occurred. Wind gusts are estimated as high as 30mph.</p>			

County Calhoun	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
<p>Hurricane Beryl made landfall just north of Calhoun county, and portions of the county were impacted by the eyewall of the storm around the time of landfall. Max winds in the county were around 50 mph, however just off the jetties outside of Port O'Connor, the TCOON station measured sustained winds of 62 mph and gusts to 76 mph. Eastern portions of Calhoun county received 2-5 inches of rain as the eyewall rotated overhead. The Port O'Connor NOS site quickly rose to 3.71' MHHW. As winds wrapped around to the north on the backside of the eyewall, the water levels fell drastically to near -0.5' in a negative surge effect. Voluntary evacuations were in place as Beryl lurked offshore. The exact number of residents that left is unknown at this time.</p>

County Goliad	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
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Wind gusts as high as 50 mph occurred in eastern Goliad county as Beryl made landfall to the east of the county. Rainfall totals were generally under an inch.

County Jim Wells	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
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Beryl remained well east of Jim Wells county so we saw minimal impacts. Wind gusts as high as 30-40 mph occurred in Jim Wells county. Rainfall totals were under a quarter of an inch.

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Beryl remained well east of Kleberg county so we saw minimal impacts. Wind gusts as high as 35-45 mph occurred in eastern Kleberg county. Rainfall totals were under an inch. A voluntary evacuation was issued for the coastal portions of the county. It is unknown how many residents evacuated at this time.

County Nueces	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: Mandatory for visitors. Voluntary for residents
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Rainbands from Beryl worked inland across the Coastal Bend as the storm slowly moved parallel to the Middle Texas coastline. Rainfall amounts were generally less than an inch with this event. However, there may be a few isolated locations across the county that received 1.5". Winds were generally in the 30-40 MPH range. The peak wind recorded was 44 MPH as a band passed through the city. Mandatory evacuations were ordered for visitors with voluntary evacuations in place for residents. It is unknown how many visitors and residents evacuated at this time.

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Rainbands from Beryl worked inland across the Coastal Bend as the storm slowly moved parallel to the Middle Texas coastline. Rainfall amounts generally ranged from 0.5" to 1.5". However, there may be a few isolated locations across the county that received 2.0". Winds were generally in the 30-40 MPH range. Mandatory evacuations were issued in advance of Beryl for the county. It is unknown at this time how many residents evacuated.

County San Patricio	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
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Rainbands from Beryl worked inland across the Coastal Bend as the storm slowly moved parallel to the Middle Texas coastline. Rainfall totals between 1 and 1.5 inches were reported in San Patricio County. Estimated winds through the county topped out around 30-35mph. A voluntary evacuation was issued for the eastern portions of the county. It is unknown how many residents evacuated at this time.

County Victoria	Injuries: 0	Fatalities: 0	Evacuations: 0
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Strong winds with gusts as high as 50 mph were measured at the Victoria airport. Stronger winds may have occurred in eastern portions of the county closer to the center of the storm and eyewall. Eastern portions of the county received 1-3" of rain while most of the county received under an inch.
