

# Citizens Weather Observing Program (CWOP) Configuration for *Davis WeatherLink.com 2.0* Users

(Last updated: 29 January 2019)

*These instructions assume you have already setup your weather station and Weatherlink.com account.*

## 1.) Gather Station Location Data

- You will need your **Latitude and Longitude** in decimal degrees and Elevation in metres. (This info may already have been entered on weatherlink.com)
- See the How-To “Signing up for CWOP” for methods to obtain your station location data: <http://www.weather.gov/media/epz/mesonet/CWOP-SignUp.pdf>

## 2.) Get a CWOP Station ID:

## 3.) Send the form, then make note of your CWOP Station ID:

**Your Citizen's Weather Account Number is: FWxxxx**

An email will be sent to John Doe (johndoe@anonymous.net) confirming this number.

## 4.) Configure Weatherlink.com:

Go to <http://www.weatherlink.com/> and login using your Weatherlink ID and password.

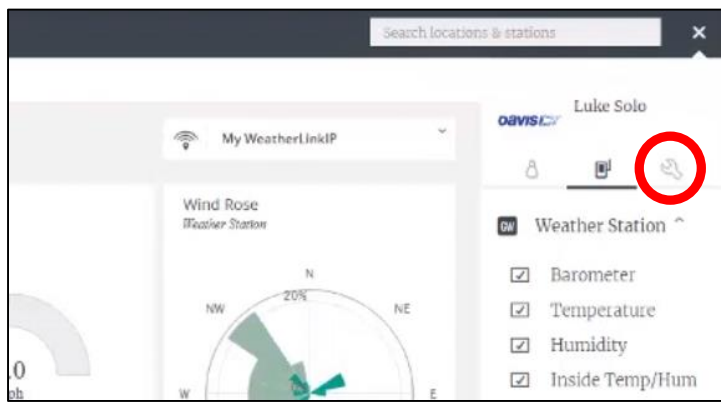

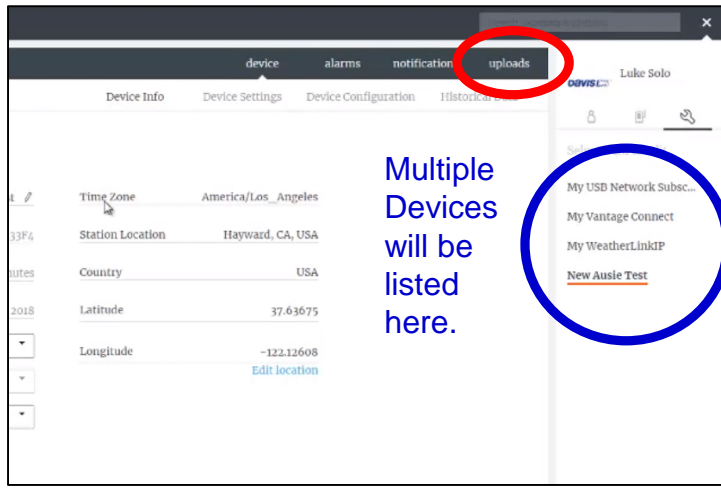
### 4.) Continued:

• After logging in, click on the settings (wrench) icon on the far right.



• The 'Device Info' screen will come up.

(If you have multiple devices, they'll show up in a list on the right. Make sure you select the correct device to setup.)



Multiple Devices will be listed here.

• Next, click "uploads" on the black bar near the upper-right.

• On the uploads page, look for the CWOP section. Click the checkbox and add your CWOP Station ID (from step 3). Leave the passcode blank.



• Click the 'Exit' button (not shown) when finished.

### 5.) Check for Data:

Note: It may take up to an hour for data to start appearing.

• You can click on the "Latest submission" link, or browse to the following web address, using your CWOP Station ID at the end:
