Thursday, January 16 through Thursday, January 23


- Rain coming in late Friday night into Saturday
 - No storm/lightning threat
 - ½ to 1" expected with locally higher amounts across central GA
- Much colder conditions expected by late Sunday into Monday
 - Wind chill values down in the 0-10F degree range by Monday morning
 - An extended period of cold/below-normal temperatures expected through the week
- Winter weather potential exists (anywhere in north & central GA) sometime Tues-Thurs but uncertainty remains high on timing, locations, amounts






Current Conditions (as of ~12PM Thurs - 1/16)

Wind gusts in **RED**








Forecast 24-Hour Rainfall Amounts (Friday night-Saturday)























































Potential # of HOURS Temps at or below 32F degrees (consecutive)
