
MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR APRIL 2011

...TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW...

Temperatures in April were near or slightly above normal for central and eastern Arizona, with slightly below normal readings for parts of northwest Arizona. Precipitation totals for the month were below normal for most locations, with the exception across localized areas of northwest Arizona. The majority of precipitation was received April 7-9 as a strong storm system crossed the region.

... April 7-9...

A STRONG STORM SYSTEM MOVED ACROSS THE STATE DURING THIS PERIOD, BRINGING MUCH BELOW NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND MODERATE TO HEAVY PRECIPITATION. SNOWFALL OCCURRED FOR MANY LOCATIONS ABOVE 4500 FEET.
