MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR APRIL 2014

...TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW...

April was typical of springtime in northern Arizona including long periods of dry and breezy weather, and two cold storm systems, one at the beginning of the month and the other toward the end of the month. Overall, temperatures were near to slightly above normal. Precipitation was generally below normal, though a few spots managed to receive near normal amounts.



Cold Front Brings Wind/Dust April 1st followed by Rain and Snow April 2nd

An approaching Pacific storm system brought strong and gusty winds to much of northern Arizona on April 1st. Areas of blowing dust reduced visibilities to below one mile, locally to 1/8 mile, in the valleys of northeast Arizona. Below are some of the peak wind gusts reported:
