### **MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR AUGUST 2016**


### ... AUGUST TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

August 2016 was cooler and wetter than normal for most of northern Arizona, with several locations among the wettest Augusts on record. Several periods of deep moisture resulted in heavy rainfall due to thunderstorms. A few areas received less than normal rainfall, mainly over lower elevations north of the Mogollon Rim, including the Page area. Increased clouds kept daytime temperatures cooler than normal.
