MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR FEBRUARY 2012

...TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW...

A ridge of high pressure was located off the West Coast during the month of February, allowing occasional low pressure systems to dive into northern Arizona from the northwest. Storms following this path into the region usually produce only light precipitation amounts, and this month was no exception. Precipitation totals for the month were less than half of normal for most locations, with some areas receiving less than 20 percent of normal. Temperatures were near normal for the month overall, though there was some tendency toward cold nights due to the dry air mass.
