MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR MARCH 2014

...TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW...

The majority of the month of March was dominated by high pressure that brought warmer than normal temperatures to northern Arizona. Early March received some much needed precipitation as a Pacific storm system brought moisture into the region. By the middle to latter part of the month, spring winds returned as a series of mostly dry cool fronts impacted the state. Some of the stronger wind events caused significant blowing dust in northeastern Arizona. Additional light precipitation fell in some areas throughout the rest of the month, but the bulk of the monthly precipitation totals were from the early March storm.
