

NWS Houston, Texas November 2024 Regional Climate Summary

... Warmest November on Record, Warmest Fall on Record...

...Scattered Rainfall Led to Drought Improvement...

After experiencing the warmest October on record for many locations, this November was the warmest November on record. This ended up being the warmest Falls on record at Houston-Hobby, the City of Houston, and the City of College Station with Palacios and the City of Galveston experiencing their 2nd warmest on record. Moist onshore flow and passing weak cold fronts did bring periods of scattered showers this month, but on average most of the area saw around one to three inches below normal rainfall. Still this rainfall was helpful in the removal of most of the D2-Severe Drought from the area leaving us with D1-Moderate Drought to D0-Abnormally Dry conditions.








Precipitation Accumulation Graph







Current ENSO Phase: Neutral

- ENSO-Neutral conditions are present, but are expected to transition to La Niña by the end of December (57% chance)
- La Niña conditions are expected to continue through the March 2025







Climate Primary Site History

Galveston (GLS)

Records for Galveston are from observations at the following locations: 67-69 Strand (April 1, 1871 - Aug 31, 1874); 23rd and the Strand (Sep 1, 1874 - July 29, 1878), 1.75 miles WSW of the previous location; the Custom House at Bath Street and the Strand (July 30, 1878 - May 8, 1882); Colorado and Santa Fe Railroad Building at 25th and the Strand (May 9, 1882 - March 14, 1883); back to the Custom House which later became the Cotton Exchange Building (March 15, 1883 - June 24, 1898), about a 1/3 of a mile E of the previous Custom House location; The Levy Building at 2223 Market Street (June 25, 1898 - Nov 26, 1900); the Trust Building at Tremont and Post Office Streets (Nov 27, 1900 - June 24, 1946), one-quarter mile south of the Levy Building; the U.S. Post Office Building at 601 Rosenberg (June 25, 1946 - 1994); Scholes Field (January 1995 to present).

City of Houston (IAH)

Records for the City of Houston are from observations at the following locations: Cotton Station from July 1881 through September 1909, Stewart Building at Preston and Fannin from September 1909 through February 1926, Shell Building at Texas and Fannin from March 1926 through August 1938, Federal Building at Franklin and Fannin from August 1938 through May 1969, Intercontinental Airport from June 1969 to the present.

College Station (CLL)

Records from 1893 through July 1951 are based on observations taken at the Texas Agriculture Experiment COOP Station main farm located 6 miles southwest of College Station. Records from August 1951 through the present are based on observations taken at Easterwood Field.

Houston Hobby (HOU)

Records are based upon observations beginning in August 1931.

Palacios (PSX)

Records are based upon observations beginning in February 1943.
