




# NWS Houston/Galveston Monthly Hydrologic Report August 2022



The month of August as a whole was vastly different from the previous two months where dryness and above normal heat constantly added onto the persisting drought. Plentiful rainfall throughout the month, especially towards the end of the month, provided much needed drought alleviation across Southeast Texas. Over 60 flood advisories were issued throughout the month, with the overwhelming majority occurring in the latter half of the month.

# **Monthly Precipitation**




## **Monthly Percent of Normal Precipitation**






# **Monthly Average Streamflow**




# **Previous Monthly Average Streamflow**




## **Soil Moisture**




# **Soil Moisture Anomaly**
