







Most of the rainfall in November fell over areas that needed it most (along the coast), especially on the last day of the month where daily rainfall records were set at Houston-Hobby and Galveston. Chambers County and part of Liberty County remain in an extreme drought (D3), but these areas received some beneficial rainfall at the end of the month. So, there is some hope that we can roll into the first full week of December with no red on the drought monitor map!

Monthly Precipitation




Monthly Percent of Normal Precipitation






Monthly Average Streamflow




Previous Monthly Average Streamflow




Soil Moisture



Soil Moisture Anomaly






