Significantly wetter than normal weather characterized the month as upper level Low pressure systems frequently tracked southeastward from the Gulf of Alaska through California. Measureable precipitation fell practically every day between the 11th and the 23rd, as two separate upper level storms, one right on the heels of the other, brought copious precipitation, the brunt of it occurring over southern California. From the 15th through the 18th, rain produced minor street and highway flooding in portions of the San Joaquin Valley. Isolated severe thunderstorms with heavy rain on the afternoon of the 21st flooded a few roads in the Kettleman City area, but there were no reports of property damage. Excessive rainfall in the Kern County desert on the 21st and 22nd brought a repeat occurrence of flooding along SR 14 and closure of a portion of Redrock Randsburg Road. In spite of above normal precipitation, all mainstem rivers remained well below their respective monitor stages this month.
