# Forecast Details

December 11, 2024  
4:44 AM

- **Cooler & drier air out of the northwest will spread into the Tennessee Valley starting today, as highs struggle to surpass the upper 40s to near 50F, while overnight lows fall more into the mid to upper 20s.**
- **Surface winds are also expected to be around 15-20 MPH with gusts near 30 MPH possible at times. Gusts may be slightly higher in elevated locations across northeast Alabama this morning.**
- **A gradual warming trend is then expected this weekend, as numerous to widespread showers return to the forecast Saturday & Saturday night.**





# Freezing Temperatures Ahead



## Protect People

Make sure to bundle up and wear layers outdoors. Have extra blankets ready in case power goes out. Check in with family and neighbors- especially those who are more at risk such as elderly or disabled



## Protect your Pipes

To prevent freezing and possible bursting of outdoor water pipes, pipes should be wrapped, drained, or allowed to drip slowly

Be sure to stay alert through checking the latest forecast

## Protect your plants

Know the temperatures thresholds of your plants. If possible, cover your plants before sunset to help retain heat
