TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Indiana has recorded over 1,400 tornadoes since 1950, resulting

in more than 5,000 injuries and 300 fatalities; and

WHEREAS, to mitigate the effects of a severe tornado, every Hoosier business,

school and family are urged to participate in the Statewide Tornado Drill scheduled for Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at approximately 10:15 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time (EDT); and

WHEREAS, Indiana experienced 76 flooding or heavy rain events in 2022,

> and since 1994, Indiana has received 12 disaster declarations related to flooding, emphasizing the unpredictability and urgency of preparedness in the face of such disasters; and

active participation in Severe Weather Preparedness Week and WHEREAS,

the Statewide Tornado Drill and adherence to safety measures are essential to enhancing community resilience and minimizing the potential impact of severe weather events on the citizens of

Indiana; and

Hoosiers deserve to be informed of planning and preparedness WHEREAS,

best practices that help minimize the number of weather-related deaths and injuries and are invaluable in helping individuals, families and businesses recover quickly and completely from

emergencies and disasters;
