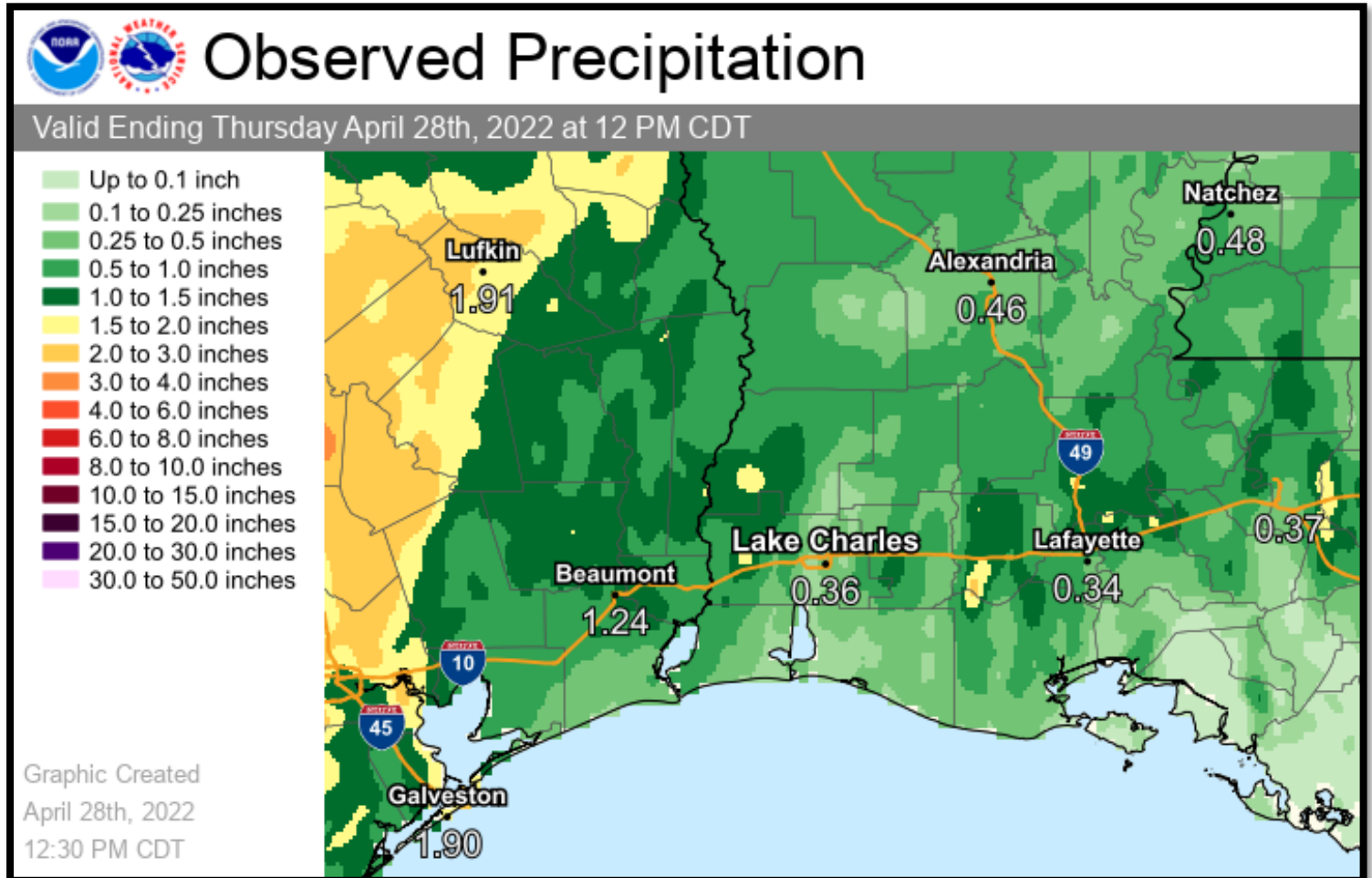
TOP STORY:

Increasing moisture is expected beginning Friday, although rainfall is not expected. Rain chances return for the weekend. Continued warm.

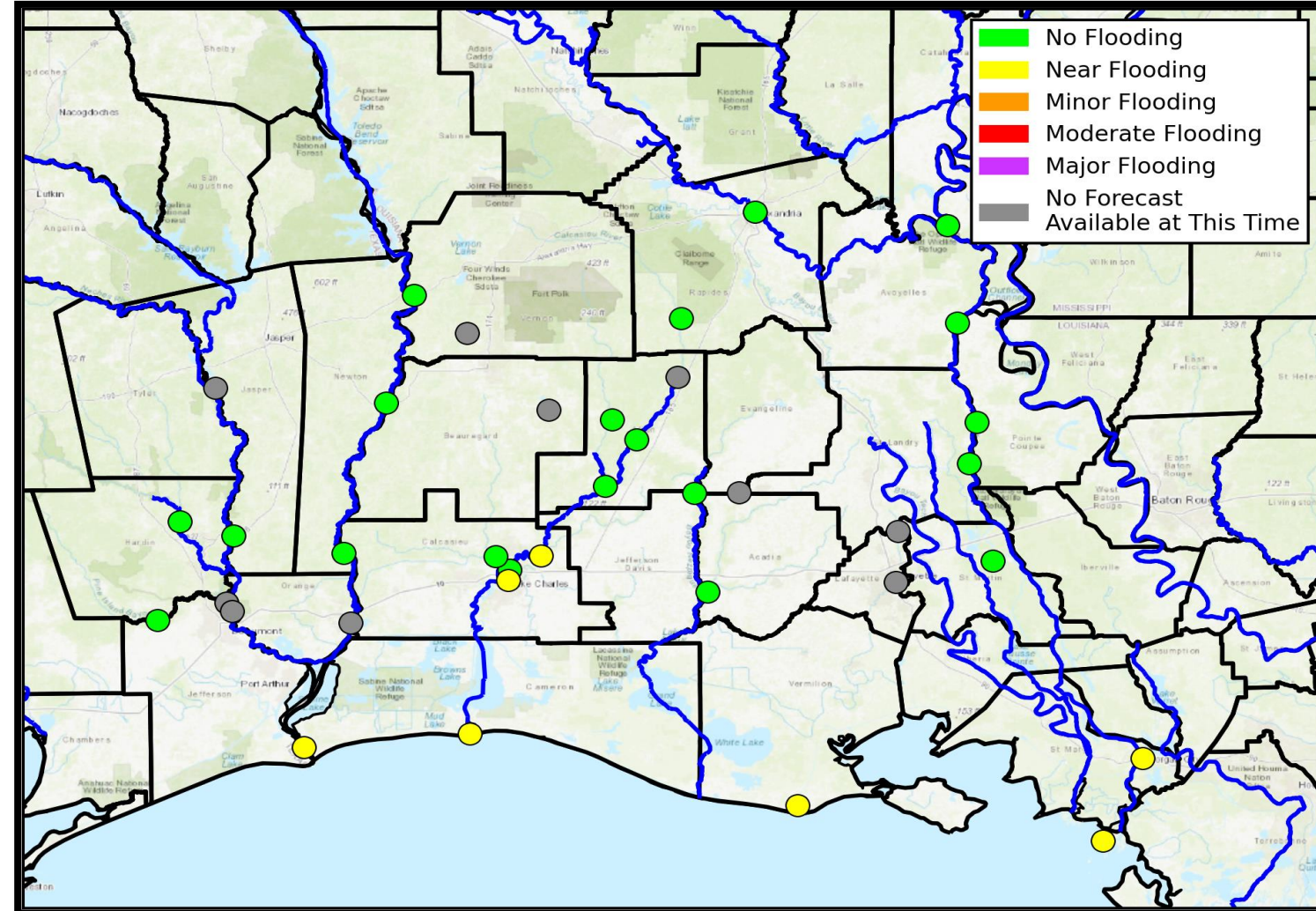

No forecast points are in or forecast to reach minor flood over the next few days.

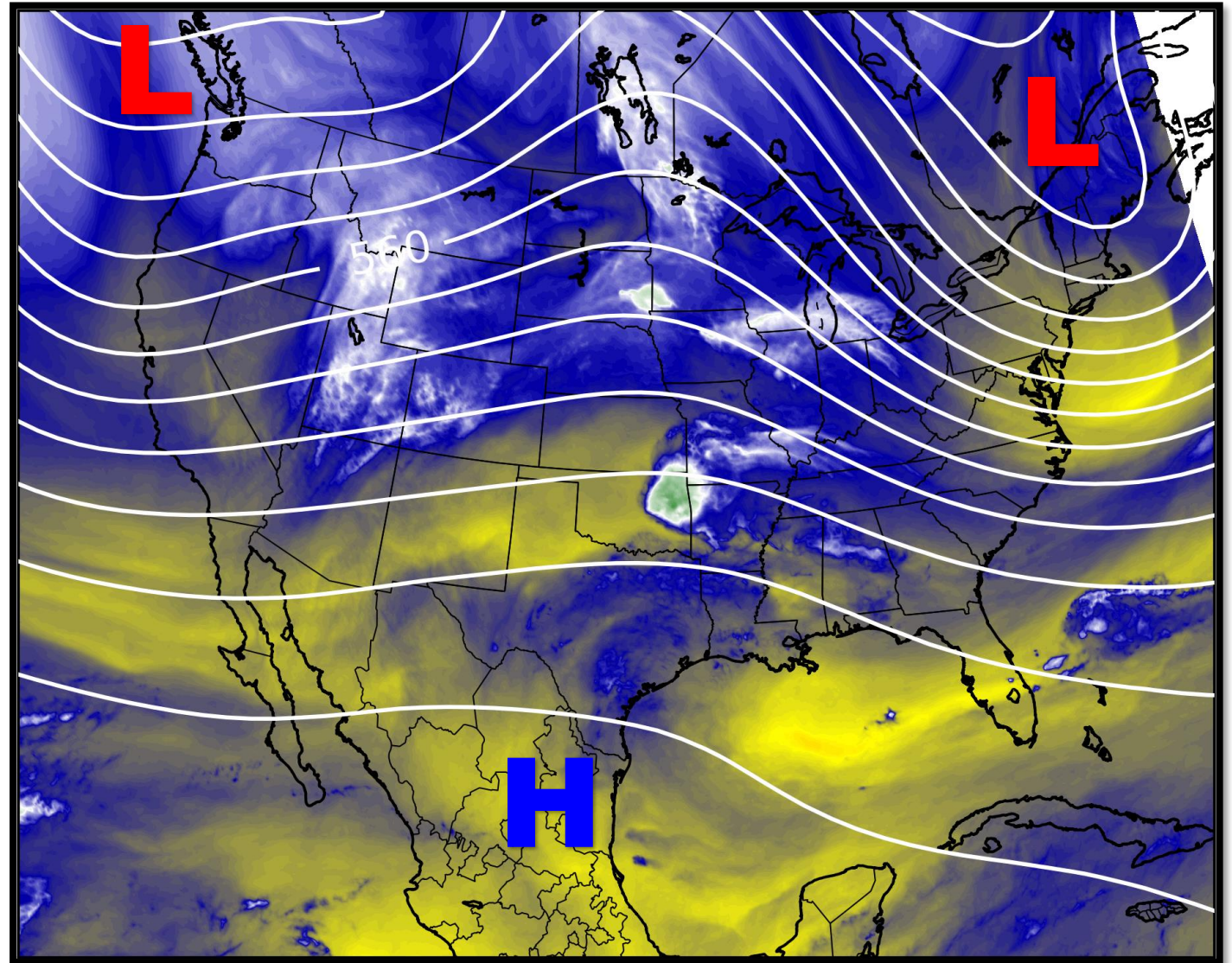


Upper Level Steering Patterns

The western Gulf Region remains under the influence of minor ridging aloft at this time.

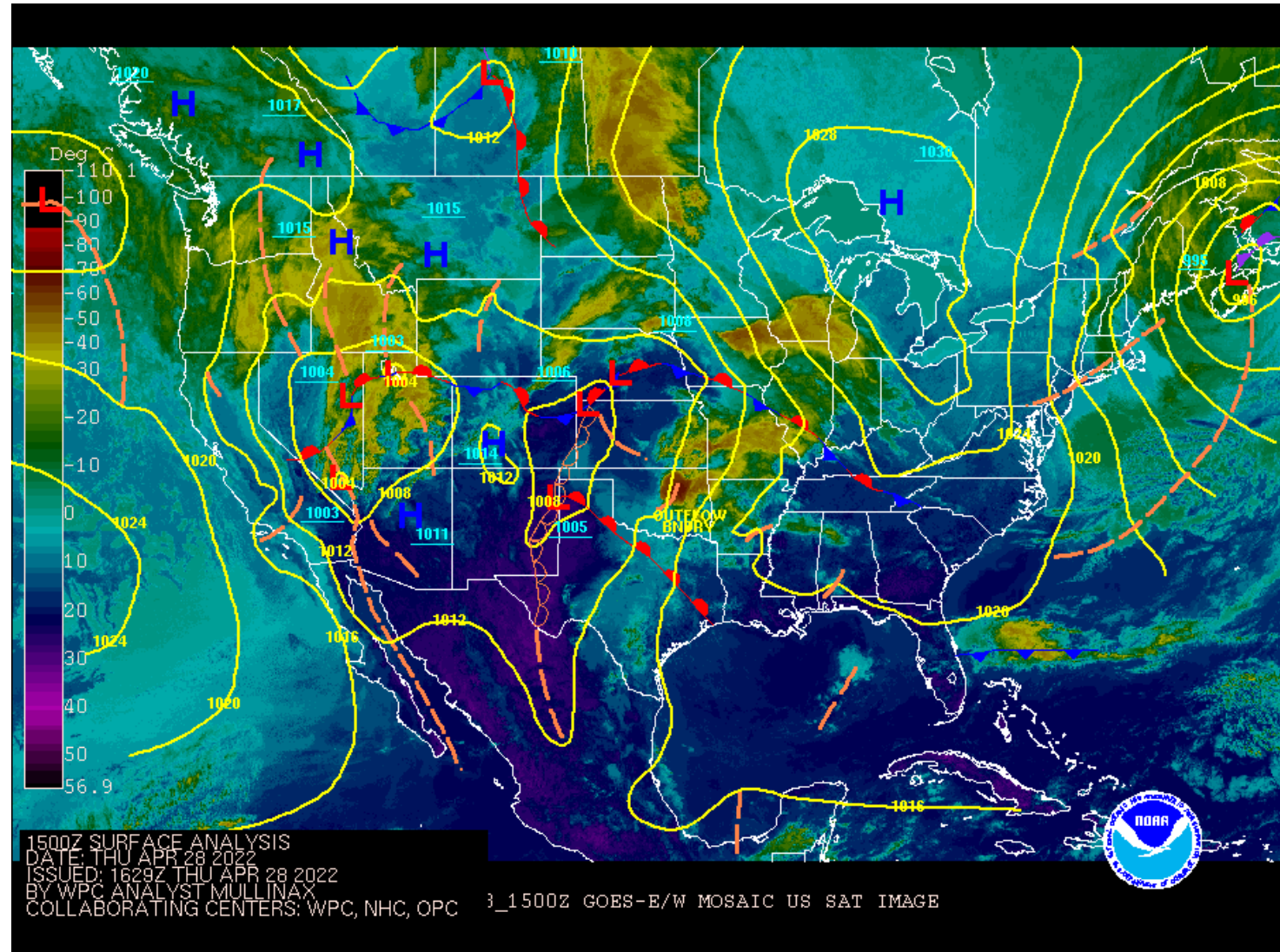


Surface Weather Map with Fronts

A warm front currently situated across Texas will cross the region later today, with southerly flow leading to increasing moisture into the weekend.

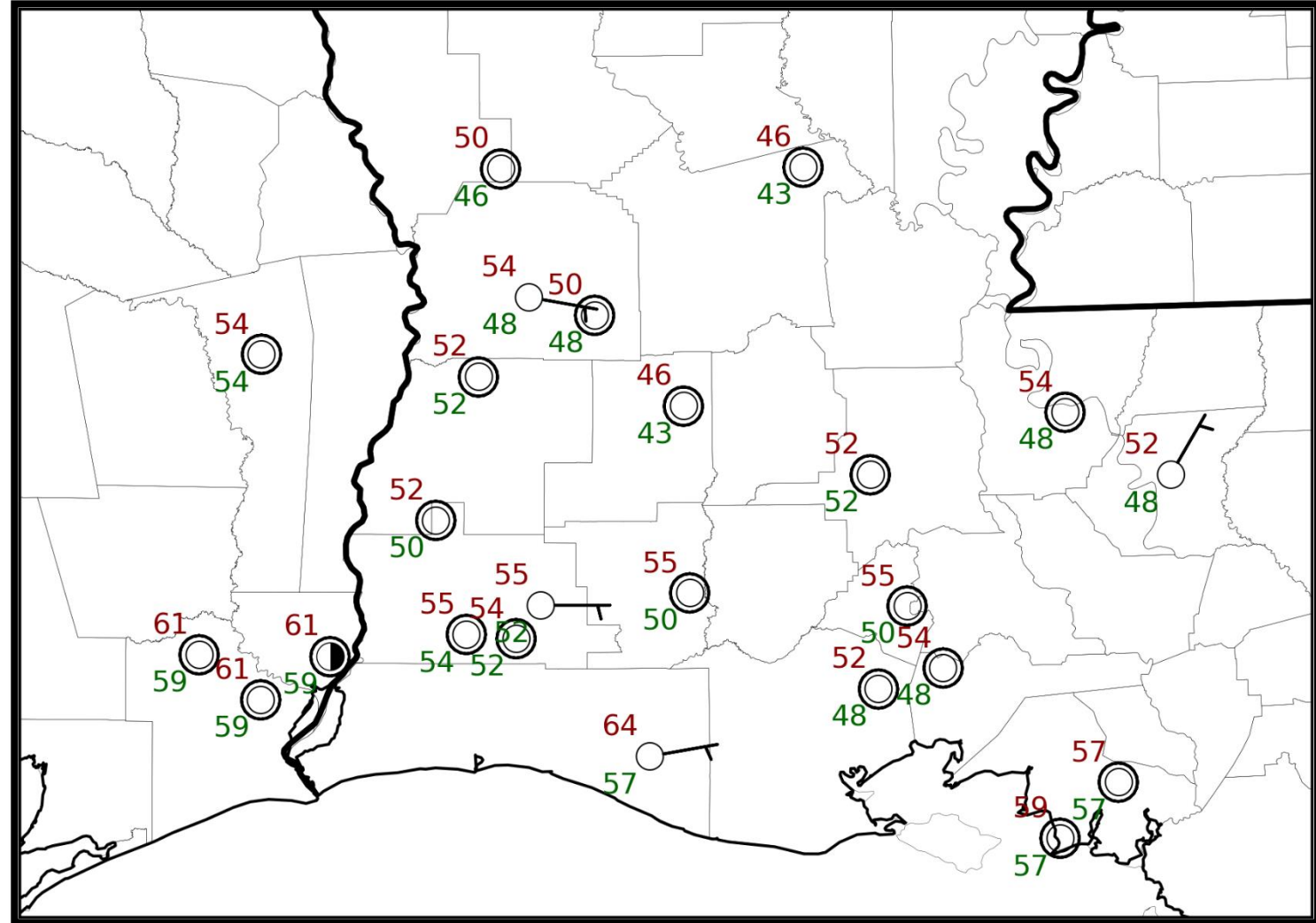


6 am Weather Observations

Cool high pressure in place over the region led to another clear and comfortable morning.

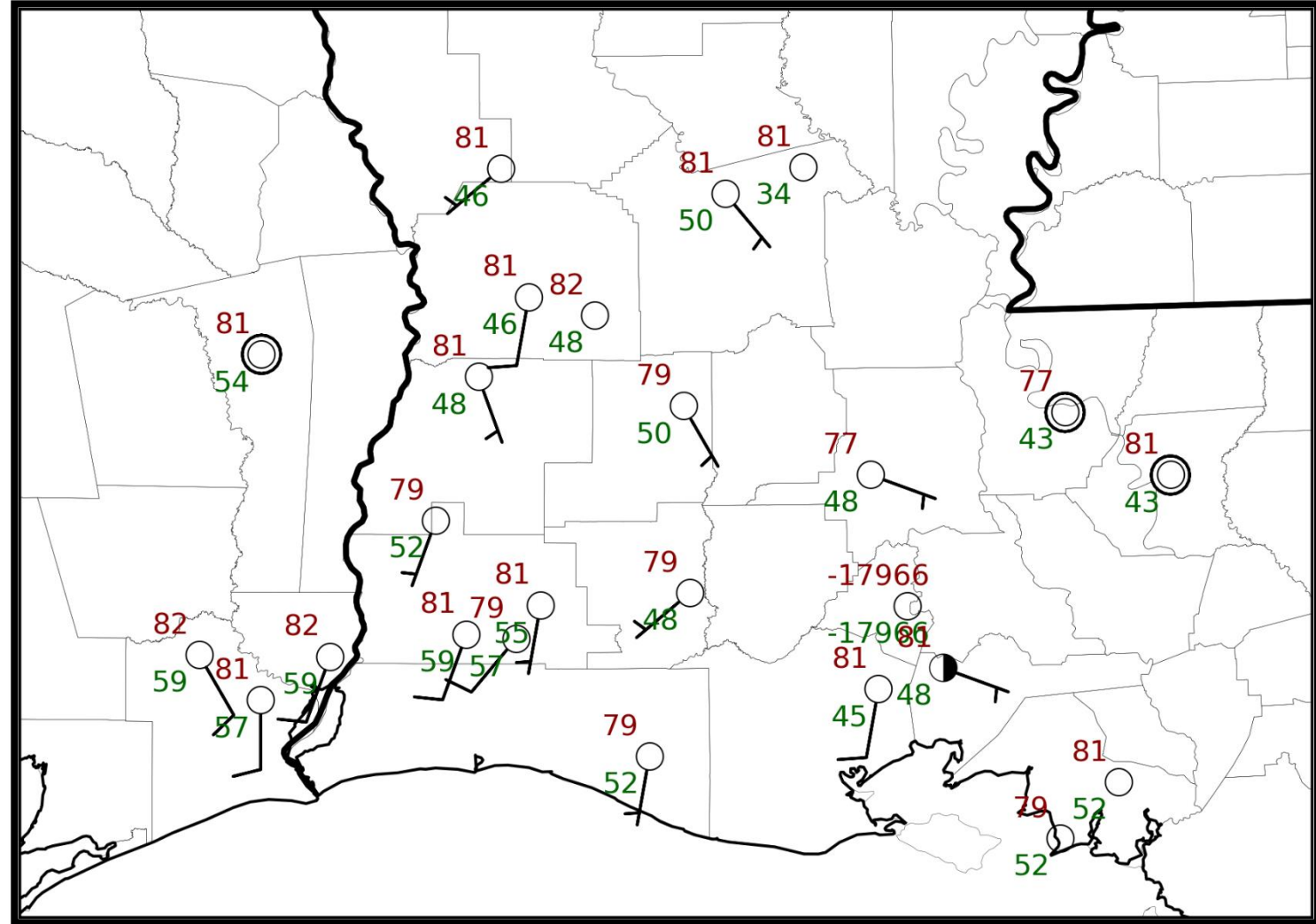


2 pm Weather Observations

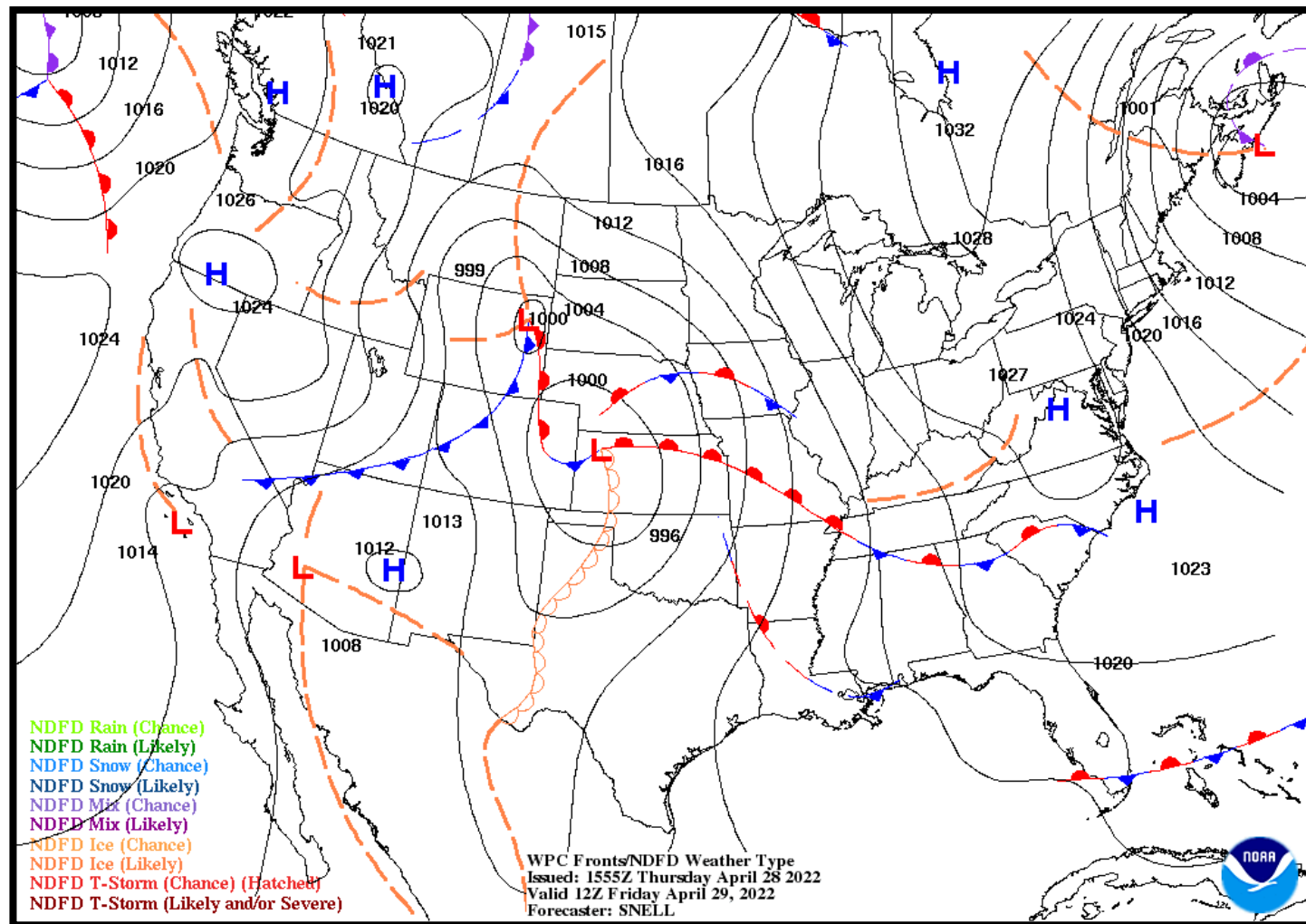
Lingering high pressure was maintaining our clear skies, while winds were generally light and variable.

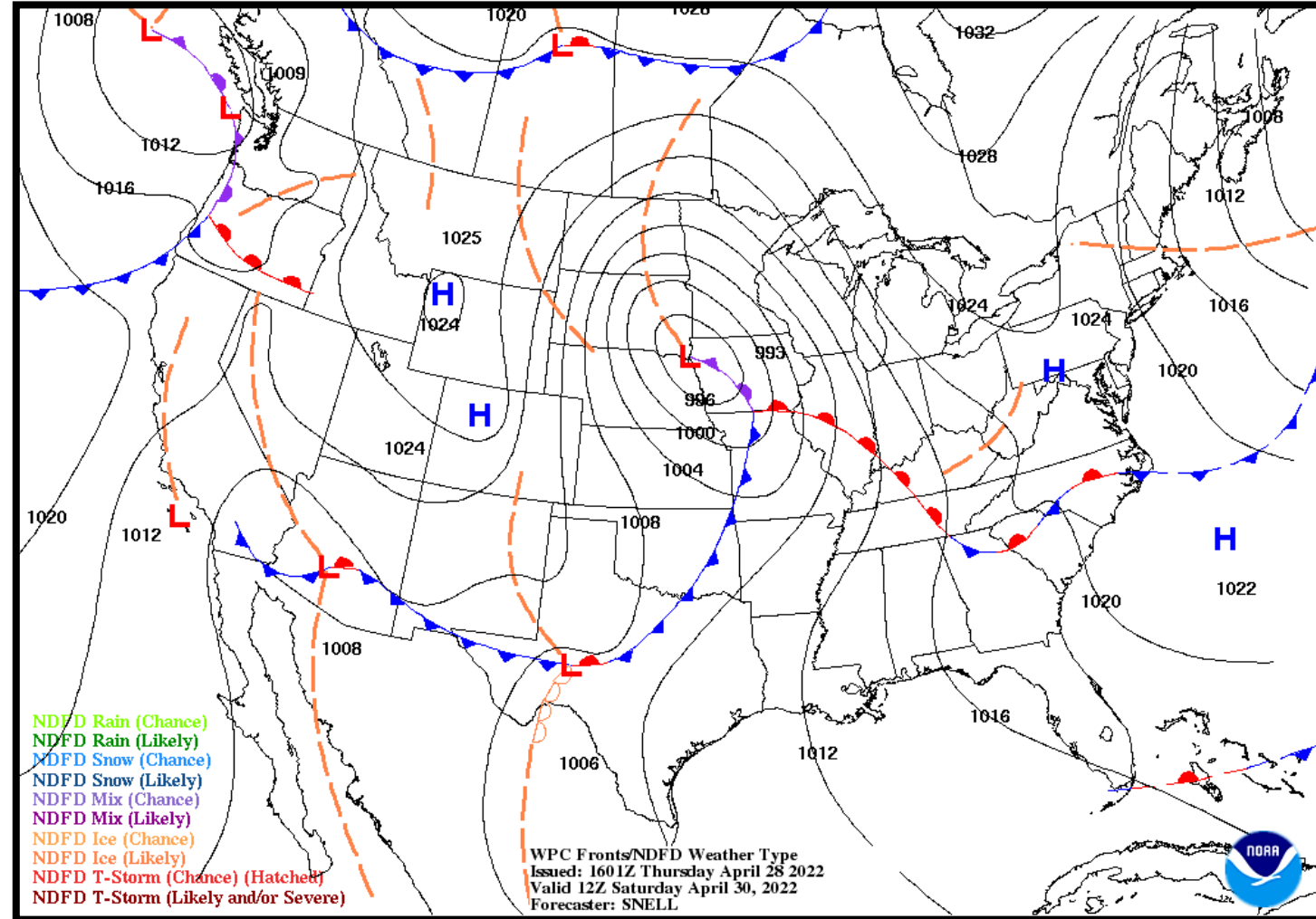

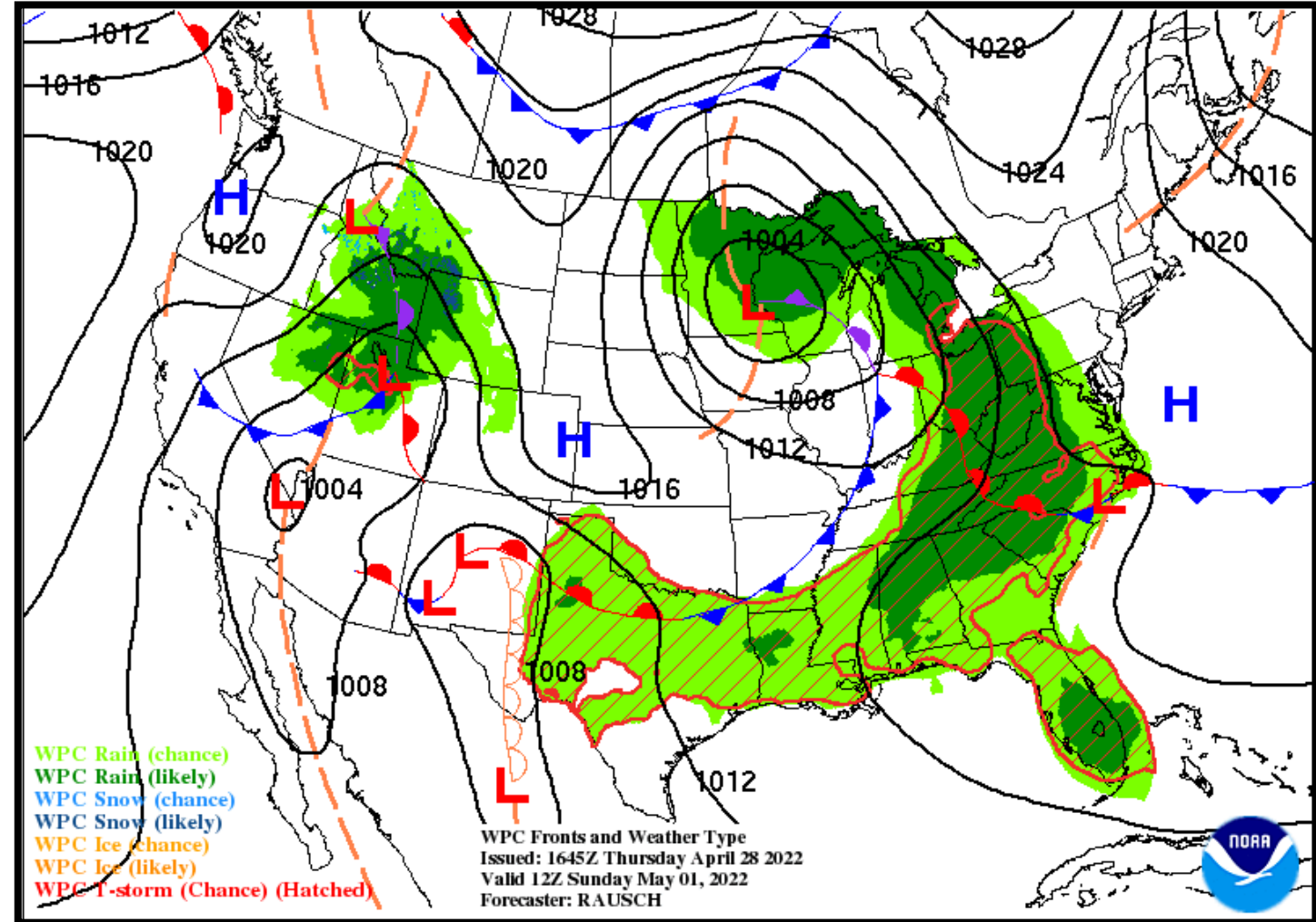
