Decreasing rain chances and hotter temperatures are expected this weekend. Daily rain chances will begin to climb again during the week.

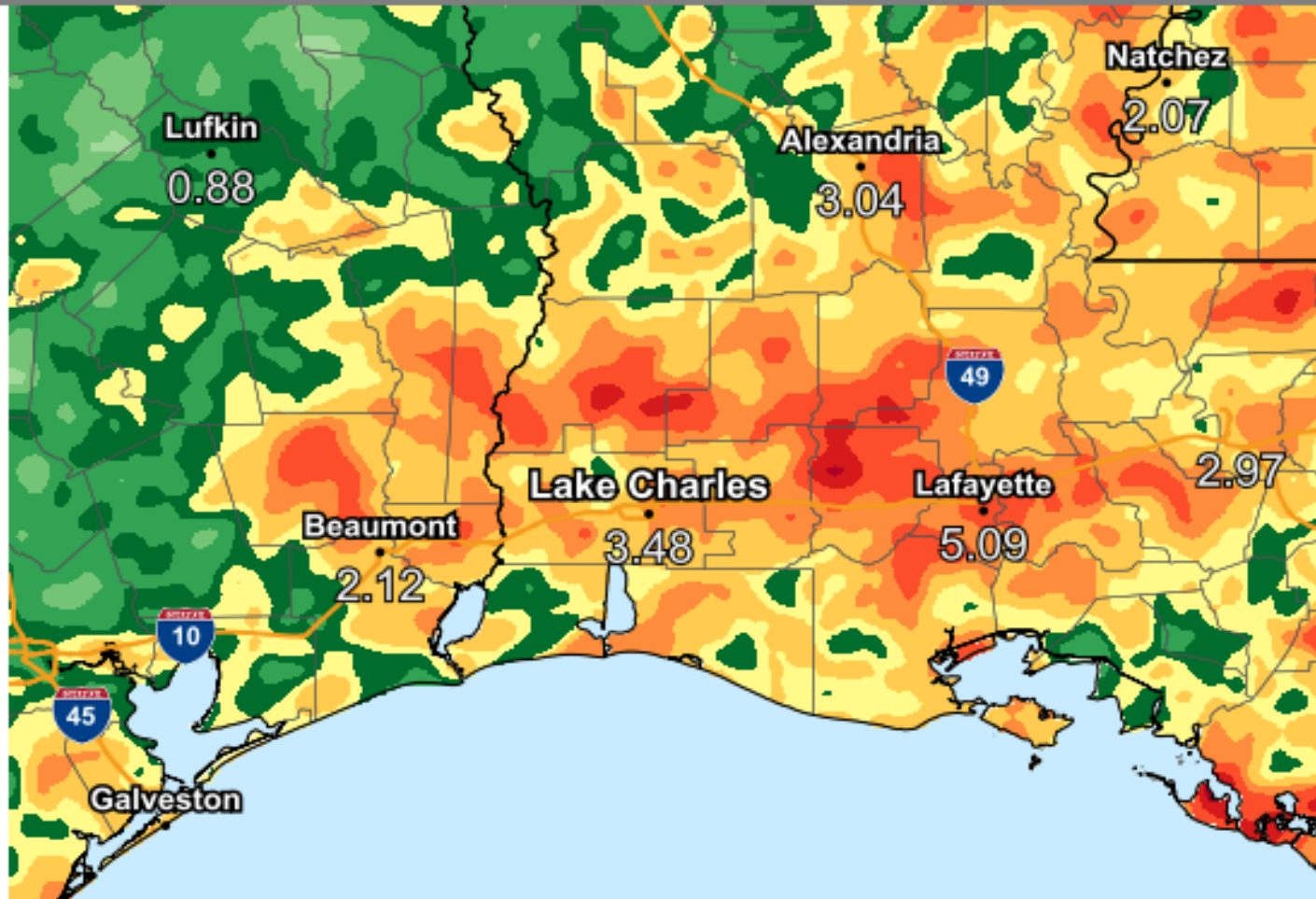

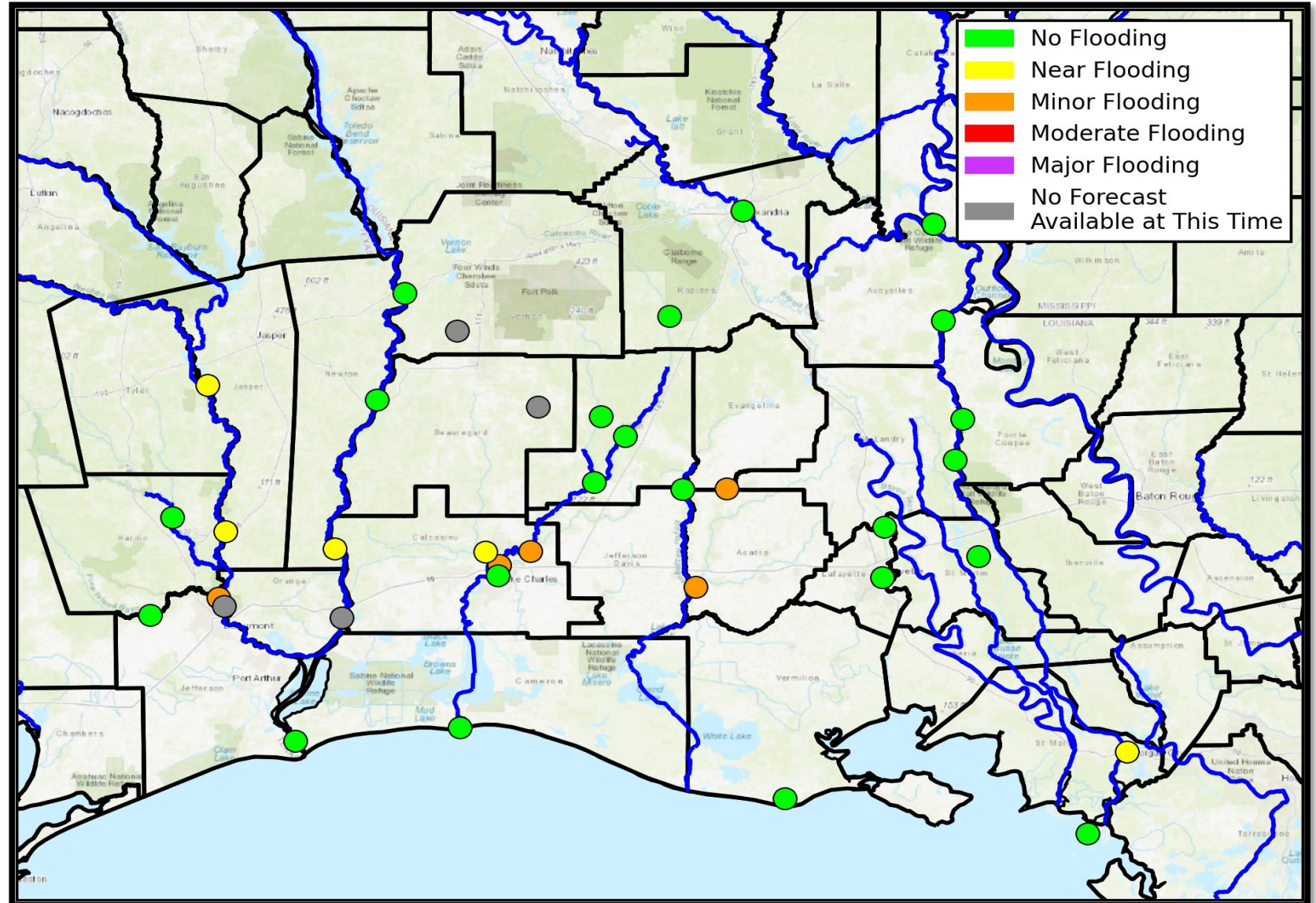

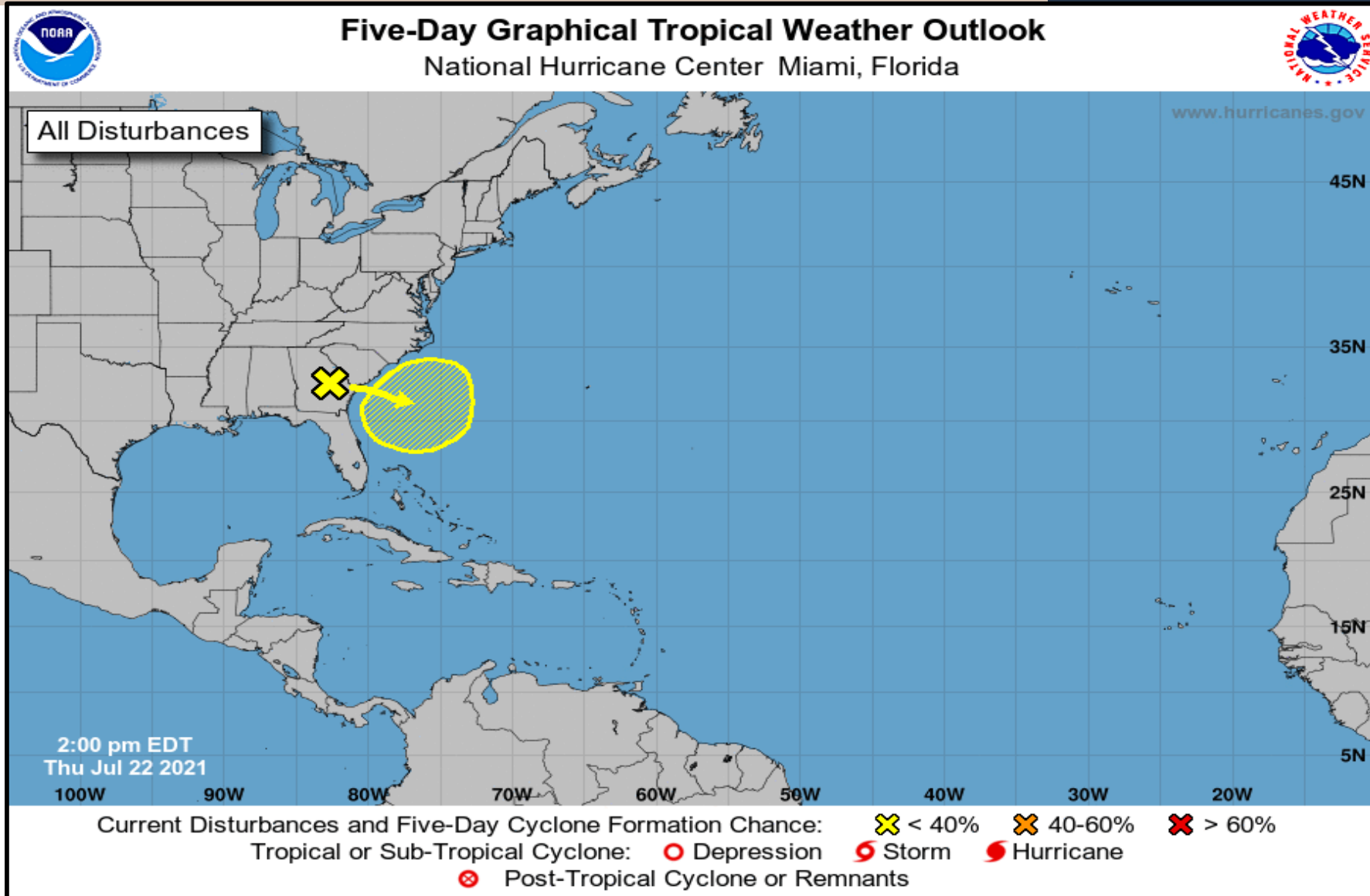
River Forecasts

Minor flooding in a few locations thanks to recent rainfall. Tidal fluctuations will also result in intermittent minor flooding on the lower Calcasieu.



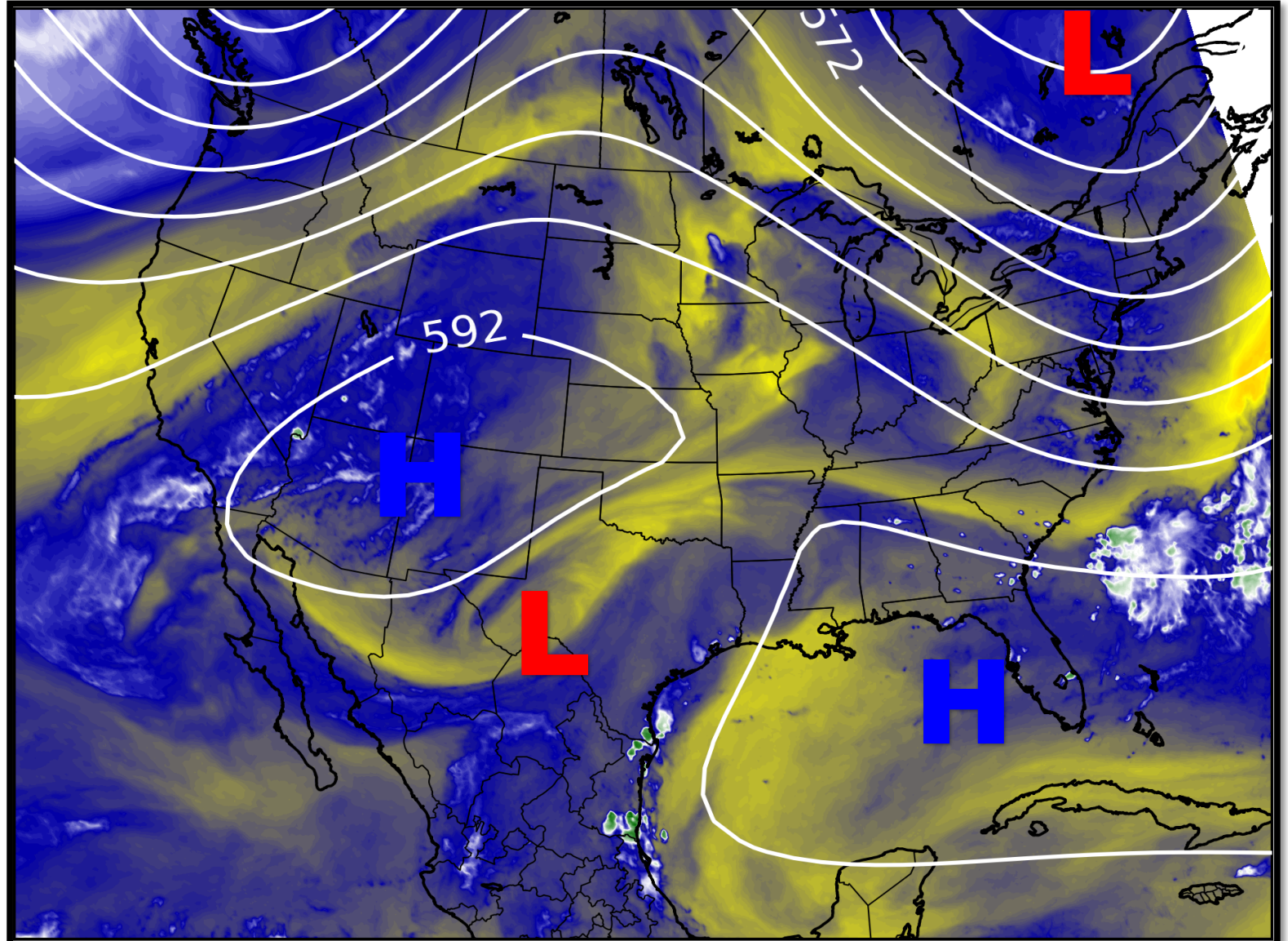


Upper Level Steering Patterns

An area of lower pressure is noted near the Big Bend area of Texas, flanked by two areas of high pressure near the Four Corners and over the eastern Gulf of Mexico.

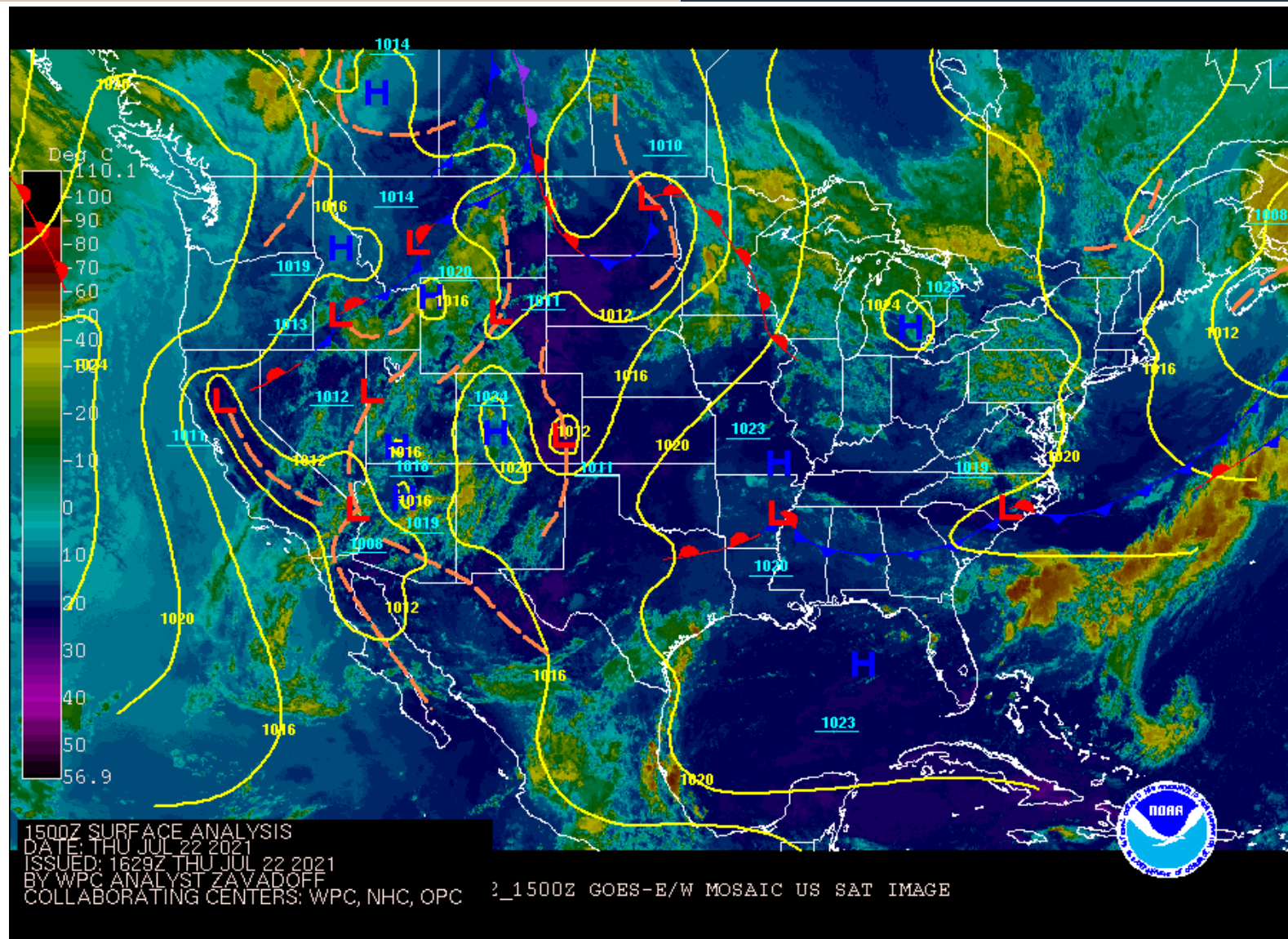


Surface Weather Map with Fronts

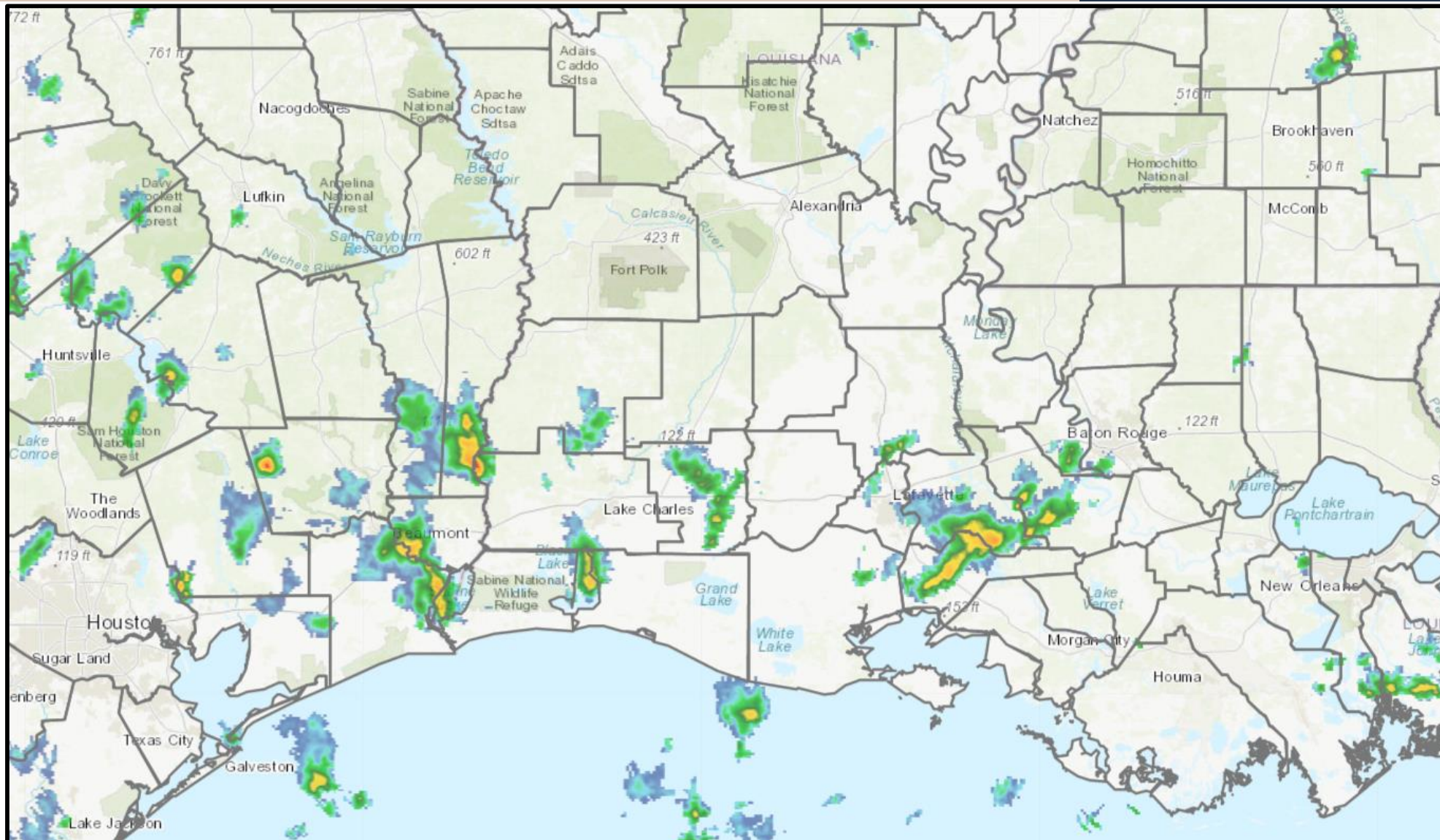
