

Severe Storms Possible Tuesday

Another Strong/Severe Storm Threat Thursday

Key Messages

- Showers and storms are expected to develop to our \rightarrow NW, and then move into our region ahead of a cold front Tuesday afternoon into Tuesday evening.
- Pockets of damaging wind and hail would be the \rightarrow main threats, along with locally heavy rainfall
- Most likely timing is between 1 to 10 PM EDT. \rightarrow

Impacts

- Pockets of damaging wind could cause minor \rightarrow structural damage and/or tree damage
- Lightning will threaten outdoor activities \rightarrow
- Heavy rainfall could cause localized flooding \rightarrow concerns including ponding of water on roadways



Wednesday - Non-Severe Storms

Locally Heavy Rain Possible from Slow Moving Storms

Key Messages

- → The cold front from Tuesday will stall over our area on Wednesday, with lingering showers and storms continuing.
- → Slow storm movement could allow for some localized heavy rainfall amounts and/or minor flooding concerns
- → No severe weather is expected on Wednesday

Impacts

- → Lightning will threaten outdoor activities
- → Heavy rainfall could cause localized flooding concerns including ponding of water on roadways



Strong Storms/Heavy Rain Possible Thursday

Localized Flash Flooding Threat May Develop

Key Messages

- Showers and storms are expected to develop to our west and then move into our area ahead of a cold front Thursday
- A few strong storms with gusty winds to 40 mph and small hail are possible
- Most likely timing Thursday afternoon and evening \rightarrow

Impacts

- Pockets of gusty winds could cause loose outdoor \rightarrow items like tents or signage to blow around
- Lightning will threaten outdoor activities \rightarrow
- Heavy rainfall could cause localized flooding \rightarrow concerns including ponding of water on roadways



Any storm that contains at least one of the following:


Wind gusts of at least 58 mph
