

Severe Storm Potential Tonight


Key Messages

- → Waves of showers and storms will ride along a stalled cold front
- → All hazards are in play (see following slides), however, the long-track tornado and destructive wind threat will be much lower than what we had last night
- → Most likely timing: this afternoon and evening

- → Isolated tornadoes possible
- → Highest chances for a tornado are in southern and eastern Kentucky

What You Can Do

- → Have a plan for when warnings are issued for your area! Make sure you have multiple ways to receive warnings, do not rely on outdoor sirens!
- Know where to shelter at home or work.






Severe Wind and Hail Probabilities





^{*} NWS defines a severe thunderstorm as measured wind gusts to at least 58 mph, and/or hail to at least one inch in diameter, and/or a tornado. All thunderstorm categories imply lightning and the potential for flooding. Categories are also tied to the probability of a severe weather event within 25 miles of your location.





Key Messages

- Multiple rounds of heavy rainfall are expected tonight through the weekend
- → Flooding will become more widespread later in the week as additional storms move through
- → The area of heaviest rainfall may shift slightly over the next few days

Impacts


- → Flash flooding due to heavy rainfall rates in thunderstorms
- → Widespread river flooding
- → Potentially life-threatening flooding







Excessive Rainfall Outlooks for Today and Friday

Friday Excessive Rainfall Outlook





Understanding WPC Excessive Rainfall Risk Categories

No Area/Label

Flash floods are generally not expected.

Flash Flooding

NO Flash Flooding

MARGINAL (MRGL)

Isolated flash floods possible

Localized and primarily affecting places that can experience rapid runoff with heavy rainfall.

SLIGHT (SLGT)

Scattered flash floods possible

Mainly localized. Most vulnerable are urban areas, roads, small streams and washes. Isolated significant flash floods possible.

MODERATE (MDT)

Numerous flash floods likely

Numerous flash flooding events with significant events possible. Many streams may flood, potentially affecting larger rivers. HIGH (HIGH)

Widespread flash floods expected

Severe, widespread flash flooding. Areas that don't normally experience flash flooding, could. Lives and property in greater danger.





This is an increasingly significant setup with potential for high impacts and <u>life-threatening flooding spanning the course of several days</u>. Be sure to prepare if you live in a flood zone!
