From 4 AM EST / 3 AM CST early tomorrow morning through 7 PM EST / 6 PM CST Monday




Significant snow and ice accumulations will result in hazardous travel and may cause numerous power outages.



Expected Snowfall Amounts


36-hour Amounts From Sunday Morning Through Monday Afternoon

Key Messages

- Amounts are subject to change.
- Highest snowfall amounts along and north of I-64.
- Snow amounts will depend on how much sleet and freezing rain falls. Freezing rain will reduce snowfall amounts but increase ice potential.

Expected Ice Accumulation


Amounts From Sunday Morning until Late Sunday Night

Key Messages

- Amounts are subject to change!
- Ice amounts will be determined by the duration of time precipitation falls as freezing rain.
- Main time of concern is Sunday afternoon into Sunday night for north central Kentucky and southern Indiana.
- Southern Kentucky is expected to see a wintry mix Sunday morning, with a change over to rain for the afternoon and evening hours.






Wind Gusts During the Storm

Very Cold After the Storm

Single Digit and Sub-Zero Temperatures Possible

Key Messages

- Temperatures will remain below freezing Monday night through Friday.
- Some locations in southern Indiana and north-central KY may drop slightly below zero Wednesday night, especially with snow on the ground.
- Thursday AM Wind Chills 5 to 5 above
- Cold temperatures will have significant impact on any locations without power after the storm. Exposed water pipes may need protection.
