Weather Summary

A deepening low pressure center moved across the Great Lakes, ushering in strong southerly flow and exceptional moisture flux from the tropics, leading to abundant precipitation across the Eastern US. Inland areas received up to several inches of snow before transitioning to rain areawide. In total, 2-4"+ of rain/liquid equivalent was reported across a broad swath of the Mid-Atlantic, which combined with roughly up to 1" of snowmelt in parts of Eastern PA and Northern NJ. Widespread Minor to Moderate river flooding occurred with Major river flooding returning to areas of New Jersey that had just experienced major flooding three weeks prior. Additional rainfall of up to 1-1.5"+ on Jan 12-13 prolonged and/or renewed river flooding at some locations.
