Weather Summary

A week after the remnants of Hurricane Debby caused flooding across the Mid-Atlantic, a slow-moving upper low over the Great Lakes led to several rounds of showers and thunderstorms. Training convection over northern New Jersey caused minor river flooding at two MARFC forecast points. Elsewhere, the same low pressure system, possibly fueled by moisture from Hurricane Ernesto well offshore, caused catastrophic flash and river flooding on Long Island and in southern Connecticut, where over 10 inches of rain fell in less than 24 hours.
