### Weather Summary

A slow-moving boundary draped across the Ohio River valley facilitated multiple rounds of rain and freezing rain. Rainfall of up to 1.5-2" was reported among the Upper Potomac and James basins. Snowmelt also contributed to the runoff on frozen soils, causing minor flooding at one MARFC forecast point in the South Branch Potomac basin. Elsewhere in West Virginia, heavier rainfall (3-4") prompted Flash Flood Emergencies west of the MARFC basin divide.
