

### Weather Summary

Widespread precipitation fell across the Mid-Atlantic region on Tuesday, March 5th into Wednesday March 6th as a cold front moved across the area. Although the heaviest rain fell closer to the coast, there was still enough rain combined with snowmelt in the southern tier of NY to cause a minor flood at Cortland. It is also worth noting that the West Branch Delaware River at Walton came within a tenth of a foot of reaching minor flood.
