Buildings in South Wilmington, DE have water half way up their first floors. In Philadelphia, the Delaware River completely submerged the first floor of buildings and destroyed 385 houses. In Philadelphia, the bridge over the junction of the Schuylkill and Delaware Rivers was swept away.
