Weather Summary

The 1915 Galveston Hurricane made landfall on August 17 in Galveston, Texas as a Category 4 storm. It turned northeast and weakened to a Category 1 hurricane near Houston before dropping to tropical storm status later on August 17. The 1915 Galveston Hurricane produced heavy rains and flooding from Missouri to New York. Exact damage totals are unknown.
