Weather Summary

Little is written about the last storm of the season. According to the Best Track data, it formed near the Cayman Islands in late October, moving up through central Cuba on Halloween night with sustained winds of only 45 mph (70 km/h). It then passed through the Bahamas slightly weaker and turned more northward and became extratropical on November 3. November 3-5, 1927 - Disastrous flooding in New England with devastation over the northern 2/3 of Vermont. The storm dissipated on November 3.
