The Great Atlantic Hurricane was an intense hurricane that paralleled the Mid-Atlantic states as it moved northward and eventually made landfall in Long Island and New England. The storm held onto hurricane strength as it passed just off the Jersey Shore on the 14th and 15th. In total, the storm dumped up to 10.00 inches of rain over parts of Northeastern New Jersey, Southeastern New York, and Connecticut. This widespread rainfall, that was reported as far inland as Central Pennsylvania, resulted in minor flooding across parts of New Jersey.
