## Weather Summary

---

An occluded low located over the Great Lakes brought precipitation to the Mid-Atlantic region on the 25th and 26th. In addition to the rain, snowmelt likely contributed to flooding as warmer air moved into the area. The high temperature in Avoca, New York, on the 25th was 48 degrees. Two day precipitation totals for the Conklin, New York, area included .66 inches near Kortright, New York, and .63 inches in Binghamton, New York.
