Weather Summary

The Millstone River at Blackwells Mills, NJ reached a crest of 9 feet on 10/20/1966 while the North Branch Rancocas Creek at Pemberton, NJ reached a crest of 2.63 feet on 10/21/1966. Both of which are categorized as a minor flood event. Majority of the rain was brought across much of the Mid-Atlantic region on the 19th by a warm front associated with a coastal low pressure system.
