Weather Summary

On the 15th of March a cold front was in the vicinity of Virginia and West Virginia bringing rain and thunderstorms to those areas. By the 16th the cold front had moved off the coast, but some precipitation in the form of snow was falling in western Virginia and eastern West Virginia. By the next day, March 17th, a low pressure system was centered right over north central Pennsylvania, and a cold front extended to the west through Ohio. This caused precipitation in the form of snow to fall in northern West Virginia. Over the 3 day period rainfall totals were: Spruce Knob, WV, 1.79"; Romney, WV, 1.16"; and Hot Springs, VA, 1.65".
