During the first week of May, a low pressure system moved through the Northeast. Areas around central NJ saw 1 to 2 inches of rain from May 6 to May 8. The storm system dropped its heaviest rain on May 8, with many locations in the Northeast seeing up to an inch of rain, including New York City and Trenton.
