Weather Summary

A deep, digging upper level trough induced a complex series of weak low pressure systems across the eastern portion of the United States. On Sunday 12/8/1974 the Delaware County area of New York was located near a warm frontal boundary that extended vertically northward from a weak secondary low ahead of the trough. This produced precipitation in the area of 0.75" to 1.5" over a three day period (12/6 to 12/8) and caused the Beaver Kill stream in Cooks Falls, NY to enter its minor flooding stage.
