Weather Summary

A cold front dumped over an inch of rain in north central New Jersey followed by additional light to moderate rainfall during the day. This area received very heavy rainfall several days earlier. - MARFC / On July 25, 1975, Rockaway River in Morris County, New Jersey crested to a level of 5.43 feet, which is roughly a foot above flood stage. A cold front moved into the area dumping over an inch of rain in north central New Jersey. With the continuation of this light to moderate rainfall during the day, it allowed for Rockaway River to crest above flood stage for the day.
